- The moon of Muharram has been sighted, the wound and grief in our hearts for Imam
 Hussein a.s becomes fresh again. The tears of zainab a.s, the helplessness of bibi Fatema
 a.s is brought back into our consciousness. Our chests crave the matam of azadari.

Kisi bahen ko bhai se na juda karna

Jab naye saal ki taqreeb ka sawaal aaye

Mere Hussein ke matam se ibteda karna

- The barkat of this month means that over the next 12 days, we will be spending a lot of time in this house of God—our mosque, with those who love God, our fellow momineen. This makes it easier to spend time in holy acts, for we are protected and sheltered in here, in the presence of company that can inspire us towards goodness.
- It is important that we not waste the moments of these holy days. As we attend the
 university of the ahlul bayt a.s. we must be on guard with our manners, with the way we
 treat Allah's property/his creatures/his loved acts/ commands etc.
- Simply arriving at the mosque is just one step in our journey towards piety—the whole body, heart, intention, acts etc have to be directed towards the pleasure of God

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This is a sacred month of great barkat and ibadat. We have been taught by our ambiyya
and aimma that this is such a special time of the year in the eyes of allah s.w.t that hajat
come true in this month

1) SACRED MONTH

Rayyan bin Shabeeb on first day of the month of Moharram visited 8th Imam Reza (a.s) asked me.

"O son of Shabeeb! Are you in the state of fasting today"?

I replied in the negative. Imam continued,

"This is the day when Prophet Zakariyyah (a.s) prayed to his Lord thus

Qala: rabbi hab lee min ladunka

dhurriyyatan tayyibatan

innaka samee ud dua

"Lord grant me from unto Thee a good offspring, Verily Thou art the Hearer of Prayers 3:38

Then Allah accepted his Prayers and commanded His Angels to go and give him glad tidings regarding the birth of his son <u>Prophet Yahya</u> (a.s). The Angels came and called out to him while he was engaged in Prayers in the niche. Hence the one who fasts on this day and asks for his desires from Allah, his prayer will be answered as was of Zakariyah."

- The second day of muharram was when Nabi Yusuf was freed from the cave
- The third day of muharram was when nabi moosa was able to cross the Nile
- It is recommended to fast in this month and seek knowledge, and treat each moment as a means of getting closer to God
- and when one also, especially spends the precious moments of this month lamenting and grieving, doing azadari of the holiest of martyrs Imam Hussein a.s, it pleases Allah s.w.t immensely. For only He knows the status of this holy imam

Then 8th Imam (a.s) said,

- "O son of Shabeeb! Moharram is such a month that the Arabs of the age of ignorance (pre-Islamic)too respected it's sanctity and forbade oppression and blood-shed in it.
- But these people (bane umayyad) did not honour the sanctity of this month nor of their Prophet. In this month they killed the son of the Prophet and imprisoned the women-folk after looting and plundering their belongings, verily Allah will never ever forgive this crime of theirs."

2) THE STATUS OF IMAM HUSSEIN A.S.

1)Our JOURNEY TO HEAVEN is a long one

- It starts starts at death with sakarat
- Goes to grave
 To BARZAKH--valley of peace or troubles (salam or barhut)
- 4) Plains of day of judgement
- Bridge over hell (pool e sirat)
- To heaven

**COMFORTABLE or difficult journey AT EACH STAGE depends on deeds collected during life on earth.

There is PUNISHMENT OF SINNERS, AND REWARDS FOR PIOUS ONES AT DIFFERENT STAGES OF JOURNEY

4) IS THIS TRUE? DO WE REALLY GO ON A JOURNEY?

Quran says [6.29] And they say: There is nothing but our life of this world, and we shall not be raised.

[45.24] And they say: There is nothing but our life in this world; we live and die and nothing destroys us but time, and they have no knowledge of that; they only conjecture.

On that day your journeying shall bring you to the presence of your Lord. (75:12)

The Prophet (pbuh) has said: "You have not been created to perish, but to remain forever. You only transfer from one home to another when you die."

IMAM ALI A.S tries to convince us in nahjul balagha that there IS life after death, that much happens to the soul after it leaves the body:

SERMON 20

- B) If you could see that has been seen by those of you who have died,
 - you would be puzzled and troubled.
 - Then you would have listened and obeyed; but what they have seen is yet curtained off from you.

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- Shortly, the curtain would be thrown off. You have been
- shown,
- provided you see and
- you have been made to listen provided you listen,
- and you have been guided if you accept guidance.
- I spoke unto you with truth.
- You have been called <u>aloud by (instructive) examples</u> and warned through items <u>full of warnings</u>. After the <u>heavenly messengers (angels)</u>, only MAN can convey message from Allah.
- · (So what I am conveying is from Allah).

** majalises are God's way of sending us truth. Therefore we must listen, reflect and act. Hearts must open, a suspension of disbelief must take place and a willingness to change must be present in order for these majalises to have effect on us.

5) WE ARE ALL GOING TO DIE

all of us on this earth, in this room right now are aware of something that we will all have to inevitably face one day—death

Kullu nafsin zaikatul mowt (every soul shall taste death)

And yet, we still can't believe it that we will die. A case in point is when we hear of news of death—we are surprised, shocked and often lament or fight with the decree of God. No matter how old the individual was, how ill we still are amazed that death took them away.

b) SHAITAN'S STRATEGY

This willful ignorance of the reality of death is one of the strategies that shaitan himself
has confessed to the Holy Prophet s.a.w as a strategy he uses to misguide the believers.

"Ya rasulalah, whenever they think of doing a good deed, I tell them there is lots of time"

c) Allah reminds us in the holy quran--EVERYTHING WILL PERISH EXCEPT GOD

'Every one on it shall perish, But will remain for ever the Face of thy Lord, the Glorious, the Gracious" (Surah-al-Rahman: 25-26).

d) BEING VIGILANT AND ALERT

Being Alert and aware that death is approaching is an act of sawab that is highly recommended by our imams.

e) HOW DID YOU BEGIN YOUR DAY TODAY IMAM HUSSEIN?

A person asked His Eminence: "O son of Allah's Messenger (s)! How did you begin your day? His Eminence replied,

- "I began the day with certainty that the Almighty Allah is above me and
- the fire (of hell) is before me and that
- · death desires me and
- · accounting has surrounded me and
- · I am caught in the whirlpool of my deeds.
- I do not get what I desire and
- I cannot avoid what I don't like,
- and my affair is in the control of someone else such that if He likes <u>He could punish or</u> forgive me.
- Then who is more needful and helpless than me?"

LILAH MERE HAAL PE ab rehm khaayi ye Ab rehm khaayi ye Juz apke siw mera koi nehi Hussein Hajat meri raw karo behre khuda hussain Dono jaha me aap he hajat rawa hussain

- It is recommended to keep the kafan with one's clothes, where it is visible.
- · The Prophet (pbuh) has said:
- "One of the qualities that purify the heart is to
- acquire a kafan."
- Doing wudhu—dua of 4th imam is a way to remember that we are headed for the burning plains on the day of judgement
- Going to funerals—pretending one is the one who died, imagining oneself at the Ghusl, burial, in grave

E) Imam Ali a.s in nahjul balagha

- I also advise you to remember death and to lessen your heedlessness towards it.
- Why should you be heedless of Him Who is NOT heedless of you?
- Why expect from him (i.e., the angel of death) who will not give you time?
- · The dead whom you have been watching suffice as preachers.
- They were carried to their graves, not riding themselves, and were placed in them but not
 of their own accord.
- It seems as if they never lived in this world and as if the next world had always been their abode.
- They have made lonely the place where they were living, and are now living where they
 used to feel lonely.
- They remained busy about what they had to leave,
- · and did not care for where they were to go.
- · Now they cannot remove themselves from evil, nor add to their virtues
- They were attached to the world and it deceived them. They trusted it and it overturned them.

F) In another sermon maula says:

- · May Allah have pity on you.
- You should therefore hasten towards (the preparation of) houses which you have been commanded to populate, and towards which you have been called and invited. Seek the completion of Allah's favours on you by exercising endurance in His obedience and abstention from His disobedience, because
- · tomorrow is close to today.
- How fast are the hours of the day, how fast are the days in the month, how fast are the months in the years and how fast the years in a life.

G) HADITH E QUDSI

Almighty Allah says:

- I wonder how a person can be happy, who is certain of death.
- I wonder at a person who is <u>certain of reckconing</u> (the Day of Judgement), but still <u>accumulates wealth</u>.

- I wonder at a person who is certain of going into the grave, but still smiles without concern.
- 4) I wonder at a person who is <u>certain of this world's doom</u>, but still <u>has tranquility in</u> loving this world.
- 5) I wonder at a person who is certain of the Hereafter and its Bounties but he still rests.
- I wonder at a person who is knowledgeable in his speech, and ignorant in his heart.
- 7) I wonder at a person who cleans him/herself with water, but does not cleanse his heart.
- I wonder at people who look for bad points in others, but is unaware of the same in themselves.
- I wonder at a person who knows that <u>Almighty Allah is aware of his actions, but still</u> commits sins.
- 10) I wonder at a person who preaches to the people, but does not preach to his own soul.
- 11) I wonder at a person who knows that he/she will <u>die alone</u>, go into the grave alone, give <u>accounts alone</u>, but is still totally engrossed with people who will not be able to help him/her.

God sends us signs that death is approaching--DEATH MESSAGE

According to an old fable, a man made an unusual agreement with Hazrat Izraeel (pbuh) - the angel of death. He told Izraeel (pbuh) that he would be willing to accompany him (as though he had a choice) only if Izraeel (pbuh) would send him a notice well in advance. The agreement was made. Weeks became months and the months into years. One bitterly cold night, as the man sat alone thinking of his success in life, Izraeel (pbuh) tapped on his shoulder. "You are here too soon" the man cried out. "You sent no messenger. I thought we had an agreement!" Izraeel

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(pbuh) whispered "Notice your hair, once it was full and black, now it has streaks of silver in it!

Observe your face in the mirror and see the wrinkles. Yes! I have sent many messages through
the years! I have kept my part. I am sorry that you are not ready for me but the order of Almighty
God cannot be averted!"

6) While death is inevitable, it musn't be feared--Fear of Death

-it is a shafa from illness, a release, it can be a cleansing, it can be the most beautiful moment in a believer's life if he has taken care of his affairs and prepared for the after-life

Lack of awareness and the failure to comprehend adequately the nature of death induce fear, dread and insecurity in man, for they make death appear to be a terrible nightmare.

Imam al-Hadi, upon whom be peace, once went to visit one of his companions who had fallen sick. The fear of death had robbed him of all tranquillity and calm, so the Imam addressed him as follows:

"O servant of God, you fear death because you do not understand it correctly. Tell me: if your body were soiled with dirt so that you were pained and discomforted and afflicted with running sores, and you knew that a washing in the bathhouse would rid you of all that filth and pain, would you not wish to avail yourself of the bath house to cleanse yourself of the dirt? Or would you be reluctant to do so and prefer to remain in your polluted state?"

The sick man replied:

"O descendant of the Messenger of God! I would definitely prefer to wash myself and become clean."

To this the Imam responded:

"Know, then, that death is exactly like the bathhouse. It represents your last chance to rid yourself of your sins and to purify yourself of evil. If death embraces you now, there can be no doubt that you will be freed of all sorrow and pain and attain everlasting happiness and joy."

Hearing these words of the Imam, the sick man changed completely and a remarkable tranquillity appeared on his face. Then in dignified fashion, he surrendered himself to death, in the shroud he had drawn around himself, full of hope in God's mercy. He closed his eyes which had now seen the truth and hastened to his eternal abode. (Ma'ani-al-Akhbar, p. 290)

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6) Imam Hussein said: Death is crossing over a bridge

At dawn the Imam(a.s.) glanced over the army of Yazid and saw Umar ibn-e-Sa'ad ordering his forces to march towards him. He gathered his followers and addressed them thus:

- · "Allah has, this day, permitted us for our martyrdom.
- So Prepare yourselves to fight against the enemies of Islam with patience and resistance.
- O sons of the noble and self respecting persons, be patient! <u>Death is nothing but a bridge which you must cross after facing trials and tribulations so as to reach Heaven and its joys.</u>
- Which of you do not like to go from this prison (world) to the lofty palaces (Paradise)?" Having heard the Imam's(a.s.) address, All his companions were overwhelmed and cried out,
- "O our Master! We are all ready to defend you and your Ahlu l-bayt, and to sacrifice our lives for the cause of Islam."

7) IMAM HUSSEIN A.S and death--HAD NO DESIRE FOR THIS WORLD

- Recited 1000 rakats in one night
- Never missed namaz shab
- · Love of prayers—requested one night to pray
- Wrote duas (dua arafa, duas on ashura) show love, trust, faith, reliance (muhabbat, bharosa, imaan, yaqeen)
- . O Allah what did he finds who lost you, and what did he loose who found you.
- Killed in sajda
- 25 hajj with imam hussein walking from medina to mecca (through mountainspaharo)—to be humble in presence of god

Hadith of imam Hussein a.s

- Some people worshipped Allah for the <u>purpose of gaining His gifts</u>. This is the worship of the <u>merchants</u>.
- Some worshipped Him for the purpose of <u>avoiding His punishment</u>. This is the worship of the <u>slaves</u>.
- Some worshipped Him as showing (ehsaan ke ehsaas, shukr) gratitude to Him.
 This is the worship of the genuine (asal) ones. It is the <u>best worship</u>.

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As he is faced with leaving medina

IMAM HUSEIN AT THE GRAVE OF PROPHET

-when pressed by Marwan and Walid to give bayat upon orders of Yazid

- · Imam Husain ('a) hurried to the side of the grave of his grandfather
- in a sorrowful and aggrieved demeanor to complain to His Eminence about the atrocities of the oppressors.
- Imam ('a) stood by the side of the grave and performed two units of Prayers.
- He became extremely affected by sentiments and he complained to His Eminence about the hardships and <u>calamities that had befallen</u> him.

"O Allah! This is the grave of your Prophet, Muhammad and I am the son of the daughter of Muhammad and what has befallen us is well known to you. O Allah, I like the good and am disgusted of evil.

- one with glory and greatness, by the right of this grave and by the one who is in it,
 - I ask You to select for me that which shall be the cause of Your pleasure and satisfaction of Your Prophet."

Imam Husain ('a) sees his Grandfather in his Dream

- Imam Husain (*a) continued to gaze at the grave of his grandfather while he had become sure that he shall not see it again ever. At that moment he began to weep.
- It was not yet dawn when His Eminence fell asleep and he saw his grandfather in dream that he has arrived with an entourage of angels.
- His Eminence took Imam Husain ('a) in his arms and kissed him on the forehead, saying: "O my son! As if I can see you in the near future, you shall be killed in Kerbala among a crowd of my community and your head shall be cut off while you shall be thirsty and water shall not be given to you.
- You will be thirsty but your thirst would not be quenched.
- In spite of committing such deed they shall be hopeful of our intercession on the Day
 of Judgment. For them there shall be no benefit with Allah.
- My dear Husain, your father, mother and brother have come to me. They are eager for you.
- Indeed, for you there are grades in Paradise that except for being martyred you cannot achieve them..."
- Imam Husain (*a) looked at his grandfather for a long time and remembered his kindness and sentiments with regard to him.

- At that moment he created an attachment with his grandfather and told him lamenting: "O my grandfather, I do not wish to remain in the world anymore. Take me with you and keep me in your house."
- The Prophet (s) was moved by this and he told him: "You must go back to the world so that you are given martyrdom and the Almighty Allah has appointed a great reward for you. You, your father and your uncle and the uncle of your father shall be raised up together so that you may enter Paradise."[1]
- His Eminence, Husain (*a) awoke worried and anxious while waves of grief and sorrow had surrounded him. He was now certain that he shall indeed be granted martyrdom.
- Then he gathered all his family members and related his dream. On that day, there
 was no one in the East or West of the world more aggrieved than the members of
 Ahle Bayt of the Messenger of Allah (s) and no man or woman wept more than
 them.[2]

Imam Husain's farewell to the Graves of his mother and brother

- In the darkness of the night His Eminence, Husain ('a) went to the grave of his mother, who was the memory of the Holy Prophet (s) and a part of His Eminence.
- He stood besides the grave for sometime while he looked at the grave with the last glance of farewell and he recalled her deep attachment and love towards him.
- · He wished the earth would split and take him to his mother below the dust.

Why is there pain?

PUNISHMENT OF SINS

- During lifetime in this world (best time—but we do so many, not possible to hand out all punishments here)
- 2) At time of death (angel of death himself will punish)
- 3) In grave (walls of grave)
- 4) Valley of troubles (mini hell-similar to hell but in milder forms)
- 5) Plains on day of judgement (intense heat)-kafirs present-humiliation
 - 1000 of years in duration, sun will come low and earth will be like red copper
- Bridge over hell (pool e sirat—good manners in ramadhan will be steadied here)
- 7) Hell -suffer for years
- *** ALLAH does not want to see his momineen suffer
- -punish them in life, dying moment or graves or bridge over hell
- -better to be punished in secret (in lifetime, in grave, dying time)
- **some don't believe or disobey so much that allah has no choice but to punish on plains of judgement and in hell
- **we know punishment awaits but don't make amends; how can a doctor help a patient who does not take his advice or have his medicines

The Quran calls out to us,

[40,39] O my people! this life of the world is only a (passing) enjoyment, and surely the hereafter is the abode to settle;

The Punishment therefore is on a graded basis. If ones sins have been answered for in this world and tawba done then Imam Ja'fer As-Sadiq (pbuh) says that death is like a fragrant breeze. However, if the sins have not been cleansed then death is painful. Imam Ja'fer As-Sadiq (pbuh) says: "Whatever a mu'min suffers at the time of death, is for the purpose of cleansing him from sins so that he would come into the hereafter pure and unblemished, deserving the eternal reward of Allah without any obstacle between him and the reward."

Man's heart never ceases to desire as long as he is in this world. Nonetheless, belief in the Hereafter will permit him to realize that the opportunities offered by this world are limited, that the gain to be had from it is very slight, that even the portion which lies within reach cannot be retained for ever, and that delight and pleasure are not restricted to the brief days here on earth. He will not be overcome every instant then, by an endless surge of desire, causing him to form countless attachments and ultimately to lose himself, nor will he be excessively troubled if he does not acquire an excessive amount of bounties of this world and the pleasures they yield.

Here we quote a sermon of Imam Ali (A.S.) as a gift for the believers: "O people! Beware of this deceitful world, for it has attracted the hearts towards evil by it's elegance and beauty. It has subdued your wishes by false promises. This world is like a woman has adorned herself only for marriage, and due to her beauty deceives men and attracts them towards her. She ultimately kills her husbands with her own hands. So the present people should take lessons from those people in the past who had fallen prey to it, and save themselves from it's conceit".

HOPES

The Commander of the faithful Ali (A.S.) says, "O people what I fear most about you are 2 things: acting according to desires and extending of hopes. As regards acting according to desires, this prevents from truth: and as regards extending of hopes, it makes one forget the next world. You should know this world is moving rapidly and nothing has remained out of it except last particles like the remnants of a vessel which has been emptied by someone.

IMAM ALI A.S says the dead are preachers

- The dead whom you have been watching suffice as preachers.
- They were carried to their graves, not riding themselves, and were placed in them but not
 of their own accord.
- It seems as if they never lived in this world and as if the next world had always been their abode.
- They have made lonely the place where they were living, and are now living where they
 used to feel lonely.
- They remained busy about what they had to leave,
- and did not care for where they were to go.
- Now they cannot remove themselves from evil, nor add to their virtues
- They were attached to the world and it deceived them. They trusted it and it overturned them.

*ATTACHMENT TO THIS WORLD MADE THEM HEEDLESS

HAZRAT LUQMAN TO SON—world has deceived many

ya bunnaiyya, the life of this world ils like a deep sea where many people have drowned let your boat be the fear of allah, your ration belief, mast reliance, helm patience, sides prayer, fast, sadqa

-whover goes to sea without that boat will drown, don't speak much, remember him everywhere for he has admonished you, made u aware, given u insight and has taught.

SAKARAT FOR PIOUS TOO?

One of the companions of Imam al-Sadiq, upon whom be peace, relates that he once posed him the following question:

"O descendant of God's Messenger! When the true believer finds himself on the threshold of death, is he grieved by the taking of his soul?"

The Imam answered:

"Never! When the messenger of death comes to take his spirit, he is at first distraught. But then the angel consoles him and says: 'O friend of God, do not distress yourself. I swear by the Lord Who sent Muhammad as His Messenger that we will treat you more kindly and gently than your father. Open your eyes and look at us.'

"Then the Messenger of God and the other preceptors of religion will appear before him, and the angel entrusted with the task of taking his soul will say to him: This is the Prophet and the leaders of religion who will be your friends and companions."

"He will then open his eyes partly, and hear God calling him as follows: O soul that has found tranquillity in the protection of Muhammad and his pure family, now return to your Lord. You have accepted as truth the authority of the Imams, and because of this you are now happy. Be certain that you have also earned thereby the pleasure of your Lord. Come now and be the companion of My chosen elite, and take up the abode that has been prepared for you in paradise everlasting.'

"Nothing could be more desirable for the believer at that moment than for his soul to take flight and receive all that it has been promised." (Furu al-Kafi, Vol. III, pp. 127-128)

- Allah says in hadith e qudsi
- If you fear of Hell fire like you fear poverty, I would have made you wealthy to such an extent that nobody would have been able to count your wealth.

- If you desire of heaven as you desire this world, I would have showered My blessings
 upon you in this world and hereafter,
- 3) Don't make your <u>heart dead</u> out of love for this world. Indeed, <u>this world is going to bring an end to you</u> very soon. The one who struggles (in the path of Allah (Jihad) is struggling for his own soul.

Imam says life is going by very fast

LUQMAN--WHEN CHOOSING WHERE TO GO

My dear son, be very particular about attending funeral prayers and avoid attending festivities. For, funerals remind one of the Hereafter and festivities divert one's attention toward this world.

DEATH IS FEARSOME EVENT

Imam Ridha (as) said, 'The most terrifying events for creatures are three: the day one is born and comes out of his mother's belly and sees the world, the day he dies and sees the afterlife and its people, and the day he is raised and sees laws he did not see in this world, and Allah (SWT) made Prophet Yahya (John the Baptist) secure in these three events and protected him from fear, and He said:

"And peace on him on the day he was born, and on the day he dies, and on the day he is raised to life." (Noble Qur'an 19:15)

And Prophet Isa (Jesus, peace upon him) the son of Maryam (Mary) made himself secures in these three events, and he said:

"And peace on me on the day I was born, and on the day I die, and on the day I am raised to life."
(Noble Qur'an 19:33)

Death is painful for:

- Momin who is in charge of people (class, community, country, jamat) but does not carry out his
 duties with justice—misuse of power
- Person who gives false testimony
- · Person who is cruel or unfair to orphans

- E) Reciting yasin near dying person
- F) Sura saffat (right after yaseen) helps sakarat
- G) Charity of clothes
- H) Pray wajib namaz at fazilat time
- Keeping mothers happy (mother's duas are accepted and quickly answered) ask mother to do duas for you, go to her grave if she has died
- J) Ziyarat of imam reza (imam himself will come)

K) AYATUL KURSI AFTER EVERY SALAAT

- b. Holy Prophet (s.a.w.) said there is no barrier between the person who recites this ayah after every prayer and Jannah except for death ie. he will be taste the pleasures of Jannah immediately after his death, and only that person will be able to recite it who is pious and righteous.
- 2) HONOURABLE DEATH-is to die a Muslim

PROVIDES WEAPONS FOR BARZAKH

I asked, "We don't have any weapons how will we win?" They replied, "If in the world you denied yourself and went against your desires, and so prepared your defense, then these defensive weapons will, God willing, have reached the battle field in advance. As Qur'an says in Surah-e-Anfal, verse 60, "Make preparation for them (the enemy) from whatever possible, strength, well-bred horses (cavalry) in order to frighten your enemies and the enemies of God."

I said, "I always thought that this verse referred to making preparations for Holy War." They replied, the laws of Qur'an are universally applicable and not restricted to the earth. Otherwise the Qur'an, would be faulty and lacking. But it is not so because it is a divine gift and has been revealed unto the last of the Prophets."

Imam Zaynul Abideen (pbuh) has said:
"Allah has said - I do not hesitate in any order except the death of a believer. He/she dislikes death and I do not like displeasing him/her. Therefore, when the time of death comes, Allah sends two angels to the believer - one is called Muskhiya and the other Munsiyya. Muskhiya makes the person generous (encouraging him/her to leave everything behind) and Munsiyya makes him/her forget the world. The angel of death (Izraeel) then arrives to remove the soul."

(This can occur up to 10 days before death)

- - -**one should be happy with long life to get opportunity to make provisions for the journey to hereafter
 - -death is only means of attaining our reward after working long and hard

- -to be rid of this world, web of deception and conspiracies, liberated from illness
- -to meet holy prophet and his ahlul bayt a.s.

Imam reza a.s went to companion's death bed

-man closed eyes at last moments and said "at present prophet, ima ali, bibi fatema, imam hasan, imam Husain and holy imams up to imam kazim are here"

Imam Ali said "everyone sees me on his or her death bed, be he a believer or an unbeliever"

Also Hadhrat Ali (A.S.) has said:

"O Harith of Hamdan, whoever dies sees me, whether he be a believer or a hypocrite".30 So far as the believers are concerned, they become happy to see the Imam (A.S.), but the hypocrites become sad when they see him.

2) Not to be feared

- -king's subject (called to report to be rewarded and honoured for service) eager to get reward and regretful that more time was not given to do more
- -death is crossing from one field of life to another which is far more beautiful and blissful beyond our imagination and power of conception
- -a child in womb is told of world outside (cannot understand) cries when born
- Imam zainul: when a mumin enters this field and sees what the merciful and beneficient allah had kept for him he will say, "why did i not come here earlier"
- Need to reform ourselves by detaching ourselves from materialistic desires and attachments
 they stick to our soul at time of death and cause intolerable pain at time of separation

"surely those who do not hope in our meeting and are pleased with this world's life and are content with it, and those who are heedless of our communications (10:7)

 O allah When you determine that death takes us away,

Bless us to welcome it as our distinguished guest

- Islam discourages wailing, crying and lamenting over demise (or being angry or worried over material reasons)
 - -eg. To ask why happiness of world was snatched from him,
 - -or why he has been deprived of comforts available from his deceased
 - -it is ok to cry for the separation and sorrow (co-traveller reached first)
 - -think of them as a musafir

6th imam: (saw a man crying and complaining too much)
Why are u crying over this calamity and not crying over a larger calamity (what awaits you in hereafter) Your crying this way, and not being anxious over your own death is the bigger calamity than death of your son.

Imam zainul O God

save us from nourishing long- drawn out expectations and ambitious plans and shorten them so that our actions are done in sincerity our state of mind should be that we do not hope and expect to complete an hour after an hour, or another day after one day another breath after a breath, or taking one step after another!

Keep us safe from the delusions of expectations, make us secure from their evils, set up death before us in display.

and let not our remembering of it come and go!

BEING LOST IN THE DAY

One day, the Commander of the Faithful, 'Ali, upon whom be peace, entered the market of Basra. He saw people utterly absorbed in themselves and the business of buying and selling; it was as if death and resurrection would never happen. This atmosphere of negligence deeply disturbed him, so he wept and said: "O servants of the world, O slaves to the worldly! Throughout the day you are busy buying and selling, swearing oaths as you do so, and your nights are spent in sleep and a state of complete unawareness. So day and night you are unaware of the hereafter and the outcome of your affair; when, then will you prepare yourselves for the journey that awaits you, and when will you gather the provisions you need? When will you begin to remember the hereafter and resurrection?"

"O descendant of God's Messenger! When the true believer finds himself on the threshold of death, is he grieved by the taking of his soul?"


The Imam answered:

"and remember we took a covenant from the children of isreal that worship none but allah and do good to your parents and relatives" (2:83)

For ease in sakarat--

- A) Keeping mothers happy (mother's duas are accepted and quickly answered) ask mother to do duas for you, go to her grave if she has died
- 1) Must spend on them

2:125 O prophet tell them that whatever you spend it is primarily for the parents and relatives (charity at home)

2) Allah praises siley rehm doers and condemns those who did not fear him:

those who join together what god has commanded to be joined and fear their lord and are afraid of the terrible reckoning (13:21)

Imam ali has commented on this ayat:

Thus, one who did not join his relationship did not fear allah. Piety without sila rehm is a thing incomplete

WHO IS CONSIDERED A RELATIVE

Covers all relatives whose relationship is known; it makes no difference whether they are within or outside the prohibited degrees or within or outside the table of inheritance

AUNT IS LIKE A MOM

It is written in the fifteenth volume of Biharul-Anwaar', that once a man came to the presence of the Holy prophet Mohammad (S.A.W.S.) and said, "O master my sin is very big (in his pre-Islamic days he had buried his daughter alive as was the custom then), you recommend to me a deed whose performance would act as compensation for it, and Allah may forgive me". The prophet (S.A.W.S.) asked him, "Then is your maternal aunt (mother's sister) alive"? He replied "Yes, she is"

The prophet (S.A.W.S.) told him to go and serve her (for she had a very near relation with his mother, thus serving her would mean serving his mother). Then He (S.A.W.S.) said, "Had his mother been alive, it would have been the best compensation (for his sins). (ma'ad)



6. Treat the members of your family with love and respect, because they act as wings with which you fly, and as hands which support you and fight for you. They are people towards whom you turn in trouble and in need.—imam ali's will

- The rights of those relatives who are not among the dependants is called sile rehm. Literally it
 means to join the womb. As the relatives are joined together through birth, this term practically
 menas to do good to relatives.
- It is here that Islamic ethics and the principal of mutual sympathy and love bring out the beauty of islam.
- Relatives must behave with mutual sympathy and cooperation and should deal with each other gently

Benefits



- Spiritual benefits
- · Maintains the unity of the family
- Peace of mind/contentment of the heart (knowing ther are people who are always ready to extend their helping hands in time of need)

Prophet (s.a.w): "The nearest of you to me in sitting on the Day of Resurrection are those who are the best of you in good manners, and the best of you is he who is the best of you (in good manners) toward his family."

Imam Reza (a.s) the closest of people to Allah's Messenger, may Allah bless him and his family, is he who shows good, mercy, and kindness toward his family and undertakes their affairs.

FISHAR E KABR AND SILEY REHM

and Ibne Maaz was one of the respected companions of the Holy Prophet. When he died, the Holy Prophet accompanied his funeral bare foot and without his cloak to show his grief. The Prophet himself laid Saad in the grave, prayed for him and said that Gabrail and Meekail along with a host of angels were present in the funeral. But when Saad's mother said, 'O Saad! You are indeed fortunate that the Holy Prophet has walked barefoot in your funeral and has lowered you in your grave, The Holy Prophet asked her to be quiet and said, You cannot prevent him from suffering the punishment of the grave. Saad did not treat his family members kindly and so is now suffering constriction.").

WAYS OF SILE REHM

To love and sympathize with the relatives and do good to them

This is the shorted definition and all the ways of sympathy and good behaviour are the ways of sile rehm

- Wealth
- Soul
- Body
- According to islam, some relatives also have some rights on one's wealth and some on one's soul
 and body

When is it compulsory

Wajib when the person concerned has some wealth left after meeting the necessary expenses of himseld and his dependants and the relative is in need of such help

A muslim must help his relatives as much as possible even when monetary help is not wajib Prophet said:

"join your relationship, even if it with a drink of water"

HOW DO WE LOVE OUR RELAITVE?

- And to visit one another's home regularly to observe the Islamic ethics in mutual relationship
- These are facets of sila rehm which one can instinctively feel and which cannot be justifiably codified in writing

Holy Prophet said:

Do sila rehm even it is by salaam (salutation)

Best Hadith

The best way to do sila rehm is not to give any trouble to the relative

TIPS ON HOW TO DO SILEY REHM

Allamah Majlisi narrates in "Zadul Ma'ad" says that do not forget your dead, for they have no power to perform good deeds, and they totally rely on their children, brothers, and relatives.

- · They eagerly await the favours.
- 1) Particularly pray for them in the Midnight Prayers (Namaze Shab), and
- after every Obligatory Prayers (Wajib Namaz).
- And never forget to pray for your parents more than anyone else whenever you visit, the sacred places, and
- perform good deeds on their behalf.
- 5) It is also narrated that there have been such children who were disowned by their parents during their life time, but were later forgiven because they performed good deeds on their behalf after their death.
- (HUQUQUN NAAS), THE best deed to be performed on behalf of one's parents or relatives, is to pay their debts and t
- (HUQUQULLAH o perform worship acts, Namaz, Roza etc.) on their behalf.
- One should also perform the Pilgrimage (Haj) for them which they left in their life-time.



LIFE IS CUT SHORT

2) Imam Ali said in one of his sermons:

Ali: yes, and it is the severance of relationships. Verily members of a family remain united and help each other so allah gives them sustenance though they be drinkers of liquor and verily members of a family separate from each other and one of them severs relationship from another so allah deprives them of their sustenance though they be pious

SCENT OF HEAVEN:

Oh Salima verily Allah created the paradise and made its scent pleasant and its scent reaches up to the distance of 2 thousand years, but will not smell its scent the person who disobeys the parent nor the one who severs relationship

(we find countless people who do good to their relatives but rarely see examples of doing good to blood thirsty relatives)

ARRIVAL IN KARBALA'

At Karbala', Hurr and his army blocked the caravan of Imam Husayn from going any farther. Hurr said, "This is near the river and you cannot go farther."

The horses of the Imam's group stopped, and Imam Husayn asked Zuhayr, "What is the name of this place"

Zuhayr answered, "Taf."

The Imam asked, "Is there any other name for this place?"

Zuhayr said, "It is also called Karbala'."

The Imam's eyes watered and he said, "O, God! I seek refuge with God from Karb (grief) and Bala (tribulation). Here is the **place** in which we will set our camp; here is the **place** where our blood will be shed. Here is the **place** where our graves will be. This is what my grandfather has told me."


ARRIVAL—on ashur day



Prophet Isa (a.s.) and his companions—LOVE OF THIS WORLD


It is narrated from Imam Ja'far as-Sadiq (a.s.) from reliable chains of narrators in *Usul al-Kafi* that he said, "One day Prophet Isa (a.s.) passed through a town, whose inhabitants, along with the birds and the animals had died at one and the same time.

- Isa (a.s.) said, "There is no doubt that death came to them as a result of divine chastisement, because if they had died one after the other, they would have buried each other."
- The companions said, "O rooh-allah Spirit of Allah! Pray to Allah that He enlivens them
 again, so that they may inform us what their character was (what sin has killed them?). In
 this way we may be able to derive a lesson and keep aloof from such sinful acts."

So, Prophet Isa (a.s.) prayed to the Almighty and a voice came in response, "O Isa (a.s.)! Call them!" When night fell, Isa (a.s.) went to an elevated spot and called out, "O people of this town!" One of the dead ones replied, "Here I am! O Spirit of Allah!" Isa (a.s.) said, "Woe upon you! What was your behavior in the world?" He replied,

- "Worship of false gods (Satans),
- · love of the world and only a little fear of God,
- very high aspirations and
- negligence by being engrossed in vain pastimes."

Prophet Isa (a.s.) asked, "HOW WAS YOUR LOVE FOR THE WORLD, and to what extent were you fond of it?"



He replied, "We loved the world as much as a child loves its mother. When the love of the world used to be kind to us we became happy. And when it turned away from us, we used to lament and become aggrieved." Prophet Isa (a.s.) asked, "How were you worshipping false gods?" He replied, "We used to obey the sinners."

"Then what was your ultimate end? Upto where has your Hereafter reached?"

He replied, "We spent the night in mirth, but when morning came, we were accosted by 'hawiyah' (fire of Hell).

Isa (a.s.) asked, "What is Hawiyah?"

"It is Sijjin (another name of hellfire)."

"What is Sijjin?"

"They are twisted (pahaar) mountains of fire, whose flames would flare upon us till the Day of Judgment."

"In such a condition, what did you say and what was the reply that you received?"

"We said, 'Send us back to the world so that we can perform good deeds.' We were told, 'You lie."

Prophet Isa (a.s.) asked, "Woe be unto you! Why did not others speak to me?"

He answered, "O Spirit of Allah! Their mouths are bridled with fire and very menacing angels are punishing them. I was living with them in the world, but I was not like them. But when the chastisement descended I was also surrounded by it. I am hanging at the side of Barzakh with a single strand of hair. I don't know whether I would continue to hang like this or get salvation."

Prophet Isa (a.s.) turned towards his companions and said, "O devotees of Allah! To eat dry bread with salt and to sleep on a bed of hay are great deeds. The success of the world and the Hereafter also lies in this."

The incident shows how a deadly sin, the love of the world is. In the light of this tradition it can be said that the love of the world hastens the descent of chastisement and causes everlasting destruction for a nation.

Allah's Messenger (sallallahu alaihe wa-sallam) said: "When the coffin is ready (for its burial) and people lift it on their shoulders, then if the deceased is a righteous person he says, 'Take me ahead,' if he is not a righteous one, then he says, 'Woe to it (me)! Where are you taking it (me)!' And his voice is audible to everything except human beings; if they heard it they would fall down unconscious

7) THE BURIAL

GOOD DEEDS CHASED AWAY BAD

I saw many wild beasts and animals, which frightened me, but the other people present were neither afraid nor even troubled, as if those beasts were their tame and beloved pets. In this way, we reached the graveyard. I stood in the grave, and saw how my body was lowered into it, head first. The moment the body was laid inside, the grave became full of animals emerging from everywhere.

My fear knew no bounds especially when the animals started attacking my body. But the man who was lowering my body was not in the least fearful, it was as if he did not even see them.



The man laid the body in the grave and then came out. But my primary interest was in my body so I stayed inside the grave. I tried to shy away the animals but they were too many for me to handle and they overcame me. One reason was that I was so overcome with fear that my very existence was trembling. I called out to the people standing above my grave for help but nobody came forward to help. On the contrary they remained busy in their work, as if they just could not see the commotion that was going on inside the grave. Suddenly certain people entered the grave from somewhere and came to my help, as the animals ran away when they saw these people. So I thanked them and asked them who they were that they had helped me in such a difficult time.

GOOD DEEDS--They smiled and replied that they were <u>my good deeds</u> that I had done and that <u>the beasts had been my evil deeds</u>. They asked me if I had not heard the verse "Verily the good deeds clear away the bad deeds". Then these people disappeared.

COMPANIONS IN GRAVE

Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) says, that when a believer is laid to rest in his grave,

- Prayers (Namaz, which he offered) remains on his right side,
- · Zakat on his left side, and
- acts of goodness & kindness (towards others) gives shelter on his head, and
- patience (shown at the time of distress) remains near him.
- When 'Munkir & Nakeer' come to question him, patience requests Namaz, Zakat, and goodness
 to surround him from all sides and give him refuge, and says that whenever troubles and
 calamities befell this man, I was always there with him (i.e he bore it patiently).

6) Once body is buried, and all people have left cemetery, soul is returned to body

7) re: WAKING UP IN GRAVE

LIFE IS BUT A DREAM

"When we wake up, we say that we understand we were sleeping and dreaming; whatever we experienced had no reality. By this we mean that our sleep was only part of the greater reality which is constituted by our waking state, for sleep is in itself a reality. Likewise, the life of this world is real in and of itself, but compared with the more expansive life that awaits us, it counts as a dream." (Quoted in *Bist Guftar*, p. 323)

Allah's Messenger (sallallahu alaihe wa-sallam) said: "(After the questioning) a man with a **beautiful face**, **beautiful garments and sweet odor** comes to the righteous slave and says: "Rejoice in what pleases you, for this is your day which you have been promised." He asks: "Who are you? For your face is perfectly beautiful and brings good." He replies: "I am your good deeds."—transformed into a handsome person who will guide throughout



BEST FRIEND IS YOUR DEEDS

"O Qays, you have a friend and companion who one day will be buried with you. When you are buried, he will still be alive although you are dead. If your companion is noble and a man of honor, he will honor you, and if he is lowly and vile, he will torment and trouble you. He will be resurrected together with you, and you will be resurrected together with him. No questions will be put to you; they will all be directed to him. Choose, then a worthy and righteous companion, for if your companion is righteous he will comfort you, but if he be wicked, you will wish to flee him in terror. That everlasting companion and friend is none other than your deeds."

Not offering thanks to Allah for His blessings and denying them, is also one of the causes of the squeeze in the grave (Fisbare Qabr).

THANKFULNESS

"It is also narrated that when prophet Ya'qoob met prophet Yusuf, He asked Him as to what befell Him, to which Yusuf replied," O father do not ask me as to what (bad) my brothers did to me, but ask me what (favour) my Lord did to me".

- Walls of grave move to pressurize, squeeze and crush the person whose deeds have failed them in their test in the grave
- · Imagine-broken bone being pressured
- All our bones will break and be crushed due to force, pain will be severe, we will scream but nobody will hear or help us
- -person who died in water will get pressure by water, air and fire (whether we are buried or not)
- · -journey to unseen world-black liquid comes out of his body
- 5 PEOPLE WILL NOT BE PUNISHED IN GRAVE:
 - 1) Mentally retarded
 - Non baligh
 - 3) Aalims with good deeds
 - 4) martyrs
 - 5) masumeen
 - 6) ALSO, people buried in kerbala—allah does not want to disturb land where shaheed *(a sincere person who wishes to be buried there will be transported by angels, a person with bad deeds will be transported OUT of kerbala)
 - *joking/laughing about it is a major sin

Haji Ali Baghdadi had the honour of meeting Imam Mahdi (A.T.F.S.) and ask him some questions. One of the questions put forward by him was that "Is it true that a person who goes for the pilgrimage (Ziarat) to the shrine of Imam Husain (A.S.) on friday night receives salvation"? Imam (A.S.) replied, "Yes, by Allah".

Haji Ali Baghdadi says that I saw tears in the eyes of Imam (A.S.). Then I asked him another question, "In the year 1269 A.H. when we went for the pilgrimage (Ziarat) to the shrine of Imam Ali-ar-Reza (A.S.), we met a nomadic Arab who was a native of Najaf. We invited him for a meal and asked him his views regarding the reward of the love of Imam Reza (A.S.). He replied, "Paradise", and said, "Since the past fifteen days I have been from the wealth of Imam Reza (A.S.), do Munkir & Nakeer' have the nerve to come near me. The food which I consumed from

the table of Imam Reza (A.S.) has turned into flesh and blood". I asked Imam Mahdi (A.T.F.S.) whether his claim was true. Imam (A.S.) replied, "Yes it is true. Imam Reza (A.S.) himself will come and save him from the questioning in the grave. For verily by Allah! My Grandfather is a Zamin (surety) Imam'.

STORY-FISHAR KABR FOR DISOBEDIENT SON

- Prophet had companion named sahib—one of most respected companions

- Died in battle of khandak (got injured and died)

- After burying, they left cemetry
- . P on his way out, looked back after 40 steps and tears started to flow from his eyes
- · People asked why
- Replied sahib is being punished inhis grave and he could hear him calling for his help (fishare)
- Because he disobeyed allah's rules—<u>did not keep his mother happy</u>, did not look after his old and ill mother
- FIRST PUNISHED FOR HIS MAJOR SIN, after that he would be rewarded for all his good deeds

- God responds: I have accepted your testimony and have forgiven all of his sins not known to you.

NABI DAWOOD AND THE HYPOCRITE

- Allah asked: Why did you not pray for him?
- Dawood (a.s.) replied: O Lord! I did not pray because You had informed me that he was a hypocrite worshipper.
- A voice came from heaven: Though it is true, a group of people has testified that he was a good man so I also confirmed it, accepted their testimony and forgave him."
- a very great kindness of the Almighty that He pardons His servants and does not punish them
 even though they were not eligible for such salvation.

-group of people who are protected from the squeezing of grave and fear and Barzakh torture are those who die between time of Zuhr on Thursday and

Friday, as these are the hours when divine mercy rains allowing such persons its full benefit. God covers them in His kindness.

This is also a kind of divine kindness that he showers on His servants.

A PURE SOUL'S BODY CAN REMAIN INTACT IN GRAVE

- Sometimes it does so happen that, owing to the soundness of the soul, the body also does not disintegrate in the grave. It remains fresh even for a thousand years.
- There are many testimonies to this fact. For instance, the body of Ibne Babuya (r.a.), around <u>one hundred fifty years</u> after his death in the time of Fateh Ali Shah, was found fresh.
- Not only this but, more astonishingly, even his kafan (shroud cloth) also was not worn out not the <u>colour of henna on his nail</u> faded out after such a long time!

INTACT BODY

- Shaykh Sadooq (r.s.) grave had a hole due to heavy raining around the year 1238 H.E.
- · When it was dug up (to refill) his body was intact

Imam Sadiq a.s: It also happens that a body is under pressure in grave and then he is given ease and comfort. Angels tell him or her that this is the <u>result of such and such good deed</u> sent to you by your such and such well-wisher in the world.

HELPING OTHERS IS HELPING GOD

The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him and his family, is reported to have said:

"God Almighty will address man as follows on the day of judgement:

1)"O Son of Adam! I was sick and you did not visit Me.'

"Then man will reply, 'How might I visit You, seeing that You are the Creator of both worlds?'
God will answer, 'Did you not know that such-and-such a servant of Mine fell sick? You did not care enough to visit him; it you had, you would have found Me with him.'

- 2)"God will then continue, 'O son of Adam! I asked you for food and you did not feed Me.' Man will reply, 'How might I feed You, seeing that You are the Creator of both worlds?' God will answer, 'Did you not know that such-and-such a servant of Mine asked you for food? You refused to feed him; if you had fed him, you would have found Me with him.'
- 3) "God will then continue, 'O son of Adam! I asked you to give Me water to drink and you refused Me.' Man will reply, 'How might I give You water to drink, seeing that Your power



holds the fate of all things in its hand?' God will answer, 'A <u>servant of Mine asked you for water</u> to drink, but you refused him. If you had given him water, you would have found Me with him." (al-Wasa'il, Vol. II, p. 636)

- Almighty God commands <u>seventy thousand angels</u> to proceed towards the grave of that lucky person.
- Every angel has, in his hand, a plate full of heavenly bounties of paradise.
- They tell the dead: Be you in peace and safety, O servant of God! O friend of God! This gift has been sent to you by such and such friend.
- Then his grave becomes brightly lit up and
- God the merciful grants him one thousand cities and also one thousand houries and a thousand precious robes and fulfils one thousand of his wishes.

NIGHT OF SADNESS

- Men close grave
- Dark, narrow place
- People going back to their houses, even my close friends, relatives and family members had deserted me and left me alone. These were the very people for whose comfort and well being I had provided and worked for day and night.
- · Their desertion and unfaithfulness on the one hand and
- my dark and narrow prison on the other extremely saddened me and I
 was close to bursting with sorrow.
- · I had never before felt such fear and bewilderment and
- I sat down dejected at the <u>head of the corpse</u>, losing all hopes of receiving any help from anybody except God.

QUESTIONING

- was wondering what would happen next,
- when suddenly the grave started trembling and dust came falling down off its walls and roof.
- It was especially violent near the foot of the grave as if some huge beast was trying to split open the grave to enter.
- Finally the grave did split and two huge men with fearful faces entered.⁽²⁾
- · The two men were strong and hefty like giants.
- Smoke and fire bellowed from their mouths and nostrils.
- In their hands were iron rods so red not that it seemed as if flames were leaping up from them.
- Suddenly they thundered in voices so sharp that the heavens and earth trembled, "Who is your Lord?"

GUIDE AND LOVE OF ALI IN GRAVE

- · When I revived and opened my eyes, I saw myself in a pleasant room.
- A handsome youth, Whose very body was fragrant was sitting next to me with my head in his lap, waiting for me to wake up.
- I sat up out of respect for him and greeted him.
- He smiled lovingly embraced me and returned my greetings, and said, "sit down and be at ease. I'm your friend and companion, not a Prophet or an Imam.
- "I asked, "May I know who you are? It is indeed my good fortune to have a companion like you. It is my desire to always remain with you."
- He replied, "My name is Haadi (Guide), I am also called Abul Wafa (the Father of fulfillment) and Abu Turab (Father of earth). I guided you to your first answer. Had you failed to reply, they would have given you a good beating with their iron rods and your grave would have become full with the flames from Hell.
- "But first, tell me, how is it that though we've never met before, you seem to know me well, and in spite of the short time that we've been together, I've developed such a love for you that I cannot bear to part with you?"

- He replied, 'I have been with you since the very first day and have always loved you but you never sensed my presence since in the material world your sight lacked the power to perceive me.
- Actually, "I am the relationship of love and friendship which you had with Imam Ali and the Ahlebait of the Holy Prophet.
- My meeting and helping a person depends upon the strength of that relationship,
- i'm called the Haadi (the guide) because the love of Ahlebait guides a man towards good deeds,.

(jab khuda ko pukara to ali agaye)

I am not going to part with you, unless you yourself part with me through following your carnal desires. This is why I am called Abul Wafa. The (father of Faithfulness) and Abu Turab (Father of Earth). (6)

The Holy Prophet told Hadhrat Ali (A.S.) "O Ali, verily those who love you will be glad in three places:

- · at the time of death, because you will be there visiting them:
- and at the questioning in the grave as you will be there teaching them (the correct replies); and
- at the time of coming before Allah, and you will be there introducing them"37

STAYING WITH AHLUL BAYT WILL GIVE US DIVIDENDS

Imam Ja'far -as-Sadiq (A.S.) and His slave.

It is related that Imam Ja'far -as-Sadiq (A.S.) had a slave. Wherever the Imam went, he accompanied Him. And when Imam (A.S.) went to the Mosque, he would look after His

mule. One day the slave was sitting at the door of the Mosque catching hold of the mule, when there came some travellers from Khurasan. One of them said, "O slave! will you plead to your master Imam Sadiq (A.S.) to accept me as His slave in your stead, and we shall surely pay you for this". The slave replied, "Yes I shall plead for you and talk to my Master".

- He then went to the presence of Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) and said, "O Master!
 May my life be your ransom. You are well aware of my services to you. If ever
 Allah gives me an opportunity of acquiring wealth, will you stop me from it"?
- Imam (A.S.) said, "I myself will give you that much wealth, but will not let you
 ask from anyone else".
- The slave then narrated the talk he had with the traveller from Khurasan. Imam
 (A.S.) heard it and said, "If you do not like living with me, I give you liberty to
 go, and accept him in your stead". After hearing these words, the slave turned his
 back and started going.
- · Imam Sadiq (A.S.) called him back and said,
- "In exchange of your services, I would like to counsel you, which will benefit
 you.
- When the day of Qayamat comes, the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) will be connected
 to Allah by His light. And Ali (A.S.) will be joined together with the Holy
 Prophet (S.A.W.S.), and we (the Aimmah) will be attached to him (A.S.), and Our
 Shi'ahs in turn will be attached to Us.
- Wherever we go, Our Shi'ahs will be alongside Us".
- When the slave heard this, he said, "O Master! I will never leave you and go, and will not exalt this world over the hereafter".
- The slave then returned to the Khurasani man and he asked him, "O slave! What
 has happened, for you went to the Imam in a good mood, while you have returned
 with a sad face"? The slave narrated the whole incident and took him to the
 presence of Imam (A.S.). Imam Ja'far-as Sadiq (A.S.) accepted his friendship, and
 requested him to give one thousand Ashrafis to His slave.
- This wretched soul (the author) also requests his Master Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.): O Master! From the day I have recognized myself I have been standing at Your door. My flesh and my skin are the outcome of Your blessings. And I desire that during the last days of my life, You will look after me and not turn me away from Your merciful door. How can I leave Your door, for the present honour has been given to me because of Your love. O Master! May I never see that day, when I have to leave Your door, and go somewhere else (I may die before this happens).

(Hayat al- Kulub- sheikh Majlisis)

SNIFFING ANGELS (BOXES)

- This time I felt two men sitting on either side; the one on the right was beautiful, but the one on left was ugly to look at.
- They were sniffing my body from head to toe and kept entering something in the files, which they had in their hands.
- he was not allowing those sins for which I had repented to be recorded.
- At times he would say that such and such sin had been compensated by a certain good deed that I had done, just as the alchemist's elixir turns earth into gold.
- When they finished writing, they folded the sheets and wrapped them around my neck like fetters,
- and they put the sealed boxes in a bag and placed it by my head.

WHAT IS IN THE BAG


In reply to my questioning, Haadi replied, "The big bag contains your luggage. Open it so that I may also see what you have brought along for your journey."

Allah says regarding the evil soul: "...when death comes to one of them (who joins partners with Allah), he says: "O My Lord! Send me back to life. In order that I may do good deeds in the things that I neglected. By no means! It is but a word he says. And before him is a Barzakh until the day they are raised up." [Soorah al-Mu'minoon (23): 99-100]

- I opened the bag and found inside the sealed boxes. Some of these contained an inscription that they were meant to be used at certain destinations.
- There were also packets of rewards and punishments containing labels that they would be opened at specific places. I asked Haadi, "What do these boxes contain?"

Haadi replied, "These are the very moments of the days and nights that you have spent in which you have done good or evil.

 Whenever an act was committed, the boxes opened like oysters and preserved your acts like valuable gems. These moments are now present in these boxes in front of you.



AFTER SNIFFING (SQUEEZING)

Then I saw them bringing an iron cage; it had thick iron bars and was about my size. They put me inside, and bolted it. Then, as they turned its lever, it started to constrict, tightening on my body. It became so tight that it became difficult to breath, and I felt that I could not even call to anybody for help.

- They kept turning the lever until the cage, which had originally been my size, was now no bigger than a small cooking vessel; small and hot.
- My bones cracked and broke and
- quite literally oil oozed out of my body, as black as soot. They mopped it
 up but I had fainted and was unaware of what was going on.

1) AVOIDING TORTURE IN THE GRAVE

BURIAL WITH JAREEDATAIN

The burying of Jareedatain (meaning: Two green branches of date tree or plum or pomegranate) along with the body of the dead is one of the things about which it is promised that these things come in the way of the chastisement in grave. Date branches are the best and they must be green.

 Imam Baqir (a.s): The Imam (a.s.) says: The body is not punished until the said branches remain green and God willing, it will not even after the branches become dry.

PRAYERS NEEDED FOR MARHOOM

Then I asked, "What is this chain in my neck?" Haadi replied, "This is your Deed Sheet. You will be judged on its basis on the Day of Judgement. For the present (in Barzakh) it is not required. As the Qur'an says in

Soora-e-Asra, verse 14,

'We have made the destiny of every human being cling to his neck and we shall bring forth for him on the Day of Resurrection a book which he will find wide open."

"Indeed, between the world and the Hereafter (that is Barzakh) are one thousand valleys, among which the easiest is Death." 6th imam

Then he said, "I see that you have very little provision for your life in the Eternal abode. I suggest that you stay here for a few Fridays as your friends and heirs in the world might send some gifts for you, because the Holy Prophet has said, 'The more provision you have in your journey (of Hereafter) the better it is' I will go now and, try to obtain a passport for you from the King of the World and the Hereafter. No orders have been issued in this regard in the past week. On Thursday night, I suggest you go and visit your family. Maybe they will think of you and pray for your well being and forgiveness."

Someone relates that he asked the Commander of the Faithful, upon whom be peace, whether the dead are able to visit their relatives. He answered that they are, whereupon the questioner asked: "When and how often?" He answered: "Every week, every month, or every year, depending of spiritual rank and capacity." (Ibid., Vol. II, p. 62)

Those A'mal which prove helpful for the people in Barzakh.

It is narrated from "Jame'ul Akhbaar" that one of the companions (Ashaab) of the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) heard him saying that,

- "Send gifts to your dead". I asked him as to what gifts could we send to the people who
 are dead.
- · He replied, "It is to give alms (sadga) on their behalf or pray for their forgiveness".
- The Prophet continued, "On every friday the spirits (Rooh) of the dead come to the homes and call out:
- O people of my house! May Allah bless you, have mercy on us.
- Whatever we have done in this world, we are facing it's consequences now, while the
 fruits of our toil is being enjoyed by others.
- Favour us by giving on our behalf <u>a dirham</u>, or <u>a bread</u>, or <u>clothes</u>, so that Allah may reward you with a <u>heavenly attire</u>".
 The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) started crying and we also started weeping.
- He cried so bitterly that he became exhausted and said, "These are your muslim brethren who lived a lavish life, and now lie pressed beneath the earth.
- They now regret their mistakes and weep over the deeds which have become the cause of their affliction.

They say: Alas! if only we had spent our wealth in the path of Allah, and not have acted miserly, we would not have to be dependent on you now. We now beg of you to send us some Sadqa".

REWARD

- In the same book it has been narrated from the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) that he said that,
 "Whatever alms (Sadqa) is given on behalf of the deceased person,
- the blessed Angels adorn it on an illuminated tray (whose light spreads across the seven heavens) and
- take it to the head of the grave and say: Peace be on you, O' inhabitant of the grave!
- · This gift has been sent to you by your relatives.
- The deceased person takes the tray into his grave, as a result of which the entire grave gets illuminated, and the grave expands in length".
- He then continued "Those who favour their departed relatives by giving alms on their behalf, it's
- reward is as big as the mountain of Ohud in the sight of Allah,
- On the day of Qayamat, Allah will give the person shelter under His Throne (Arsh), when there will be no other shelter except this.
- Hence this sadga proves useful for the living person as well as the dead one".

Plate of apples--Fateha recited

"Somebody passed by your grave today and recited Surah-e-Fateha for you. Since his was a sincere act, the Merciful decided that you should be promptly rewarded. May God bless him too."

IMAM VISITS GRAVE

Then Haadi busied himself in decorating my room. He arranged the divans, sofas and the chairs, and hung ornaments on the walls. A chandelier was also fixed and its light was bright and luminescent as the sun. I said, "Haadi, you yourself said that this is not my permanent place. Then why are you taking so much pains today in decorating this room?" He replied, "I have received information that the Imam's son whose grave you had visited once, and the

religious scholars whom you used to remember in your Night Prayers are coming to visit you in order to thank you for your friendship."

I replied, "This is indeed my good fortune and it compensates for the sadness that I felt after visiting my family."

I kept thinking that such good fortune was indeed more then what a sinner like me could ever have hoped for. (9)

Then I asked Habib, "Why are these two dressed in full battle attire, when there is no war going on?"

Hazrat Habib's face became pale and he started crying. Then he replied, "In Karbala these two could not fight to their heart's content. They had intended to completely destroy the enemy and send them headlong to Hell, but God did not wish this and so their desire could not materialise. They bowed down to God's will, but their intention remained embossed in their hearts and here it has taken this form. They will remain attired in this way until our Twelfth Imam avenges the blood of Hussain (Peace be upon him)."

SOULS HANG AROUND

 whole earth. Likewise, the souls covering or encirclement is Ilmi (concerned with knowledge and
 comprehension).

- BARZAKH.
 - -One of the dreaded stages of the Hereafter
- 'Barzakh' literally means a <u>curtain or a separator</u> which lies between two things and does not allow them to meet each other.

 Almighty Allah has set between them a barrier so they do not intermingle.
 - "He has made the two seas to flow freely (so that) they meet together, Between them is a barrier which they cannot pass". (Surah-ar-Rahman: 19 20).

Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) says, "By Allah! I fear a lot for your state in Barzakh".

BARZAKH AND OUR WORLD

- Barzakh is also called a corporeal or a non-material world (<u>Alame Misali</u>)
 because some what it seems like this world,
- but it's nature and matter is totally different.
- this world can be compared to the womb of the mother in comparison to barzakh.
- Scholars and hadith explain this world of ours, along with its vast lands and skies, if compared with the realm of Barzakh, is like a tiny spot in an endlessly big forest.

BARZAKH AND THE BODY

- In the same manner the body of a human in Barzakh will be the likeness of the one in this world.
- Imam Jafar (a.s.) says:
- "If you see that Misali body you will say: Lo, it is the same worldly body."
 Beharul Anwaar



- It means that in Barzakh the physical components of a man will be the same as in this world, but will be independent of <u>matter</u>.
- In fact it will be more pleasant and <u>lighter (Lateef) than air</u>, and will be transparent.
- one does not experience physical pains like headache, toothache and such other troubles.
- Our bodies will be allegorical (misaali). They will appear like worldly bodies (but no skin or flesh) It will be an elegant, fine and exquisite body. It will be finer than air.
- There will be no barriers for it which our bodies face in this material world.
 It (the Barzakh body) can see anything and everything from everywhere everytime. There will be no difference for observation whether some thing is on this did of a wall or on the other side.

MISALI BODY CAN TRAVEL

- As in dreams, we will be able to travel immeasurable distances in a split second.
- We can reach Holy Mecca, Holy Mashhad and all other places.
- We also see and hear people over there and also talk there. But all these things are not performed by bodily organs.
- · Not only this, better and higher and finer things like various kinds of
- · tasty food,
- · good-looking faces and
- · pleasing fragrance as well as
- attractive songs etc are also instantly available to the Misali body, things
 which are unimaginable here.

FEELINGS IN BARZAKH

- The pleasures which we derive in this world are nothing as compared to those in that stage. Because the <u>reality lies THERE</u> whereas here (like when we dream) is the *likeness* of it.
- If a Hoorie' looks towards this world and lifts up the veil an inch off her face, the light of the sun would seem nothing in front of the light

emanating from her glowing face. And the eyes would turn blind, hence complete beauty lies there.

"Surely We have made whatever is on the earth an embellishment for it, so that we may try them (as to) which of them is the best in deeds". Surah-aI-Kahf: 7.

ALL GOOD FEELINGS FOR SOUL

Imam al-Sadiq, upon whom be peace, says:

"The believer visits his dear ones and relatives, and he sees what he loves, while whatever he dislikes is concealed from him. The unbeliever also visits his dear ones and relatives, but he sees what he hates and dislikes, while whatever he loves is concealed from him.

FOOD IN BARZAKH

- These fruits and these sweets and the pleasure which we derive in this world are in comparison with those in the realm of Barzakh, like a drop in the ocean.
- · The tastefulness there is immeasurably more than it is here.
- In short, the things of that realm are lateef (fine) and are not made up of matter, one thing turns into another and into many other forms and shapes instantly at the will of the faithful.

PROPHET S.A.W HAMZA A.S

I saw my respectable uncle Hamza after his martyrdom. A plateful of heavenly pomegranate was in front of him. He was eating from that plate. All of a sudden, I saw that the pomegranate at once changed into date fruit.

- Holy Prophet said: I asked my honourable uncle
- what kinds of deeds are most beneficial there (in the Hereafter)?
- He said: Three things count here the most:
 - 2) reciting Durood to the Holy Prophet and His Progeny and
 - 3) love for Ali Bin Abi Talib).

BARZAKH AND INTELLECT

- In the state of Barzakh the intellect of the corporeal body is very strong.
- when one goes away from this material world of water and earth all languages are equally comprehensible for him or her. Linguistic limitations belong only to the material world.
- That is why(taqleen) recited in the Arabic language be understood by a non-Arab body

SPIRITS ARE RELATED TO THE GRAVE AND CAN HEAR

- The spirit receives reward or punishment in the grave.
- But due to it's long relation with the body, the body also feels pain and is
 effected.



- Those people who say that it is of no use to visit the graves, for the spirit (Rooh) of the believer is not present there but is in 'wadi-us Salaam', <u>THIS</u> IS NOT TRUE.
- Imam Ja'far as-Sadiq (A.S.):

Verily the Spirit (Rooh) of the believer is in 'Wadi-us-salaam, but it surely keeps an eye on what is happening in the grave. It also looks at the people who have come to visit his grave.

- Imam Sadiq (a.s): though the souls live in Waadiyus Salaam, their relations with graves remain intact and they know about the visitor and they recognize them.
- The Holy Imam has said that souls are like sun. The sun remains in the sky
 its rays cover the whole earth. Likewise, the souls covering or encirclement
 is Ilmi (concerned with knowledge and comprehension).

VISITING THE GRAVE

<u>Allamah Naraqi</u> relates in 'Khazaen': In the days of my youth in Isfahan, one day I accompanied my respected father and companions to a friend's place on the day of 'Naoroz' to meet him.

- The friend lived near a cemetery. To relieve ourselves of fatigue and also with the intention of getting reward., we stopped by the graveyard to recite 'fateha' for the departed mo'meneen.
- One of our friends who was humorous turned towards a grave and said, "O occupant of the grave! will you accept us as your guests today on this day of Idd"?
- Back came the reply, "Sure, next week on tuesday you all will be my guests". We were horrified and concluded that only some days of our lives were left. We started performing good deeds and rectifying the bad ones.
- We also started writing our wills. The day of tuesday dawned but none of us died. We met together went to the cemetery.
- One of us went forward and called to the grave, "O occupant of the grave!
 Please do as you had promised", and back came the reply, "Welcome".
- Suddenly we realized that the curtains of the hidden were lifted off our eyes, and we saw
- a green and beautiful garden in which were flowing streams of cool and pleasant water.

- The gardens were laden with colourful fruits, and beautiful birds were praising Allah on the trees.
- · We reached a mansion in the midst of the garden.
- · When he saw us he got up to welcome.
- Different types of fruits and sweets were served, the likeness of which cannot be imagined nor described.
- · We ate to our full, but were still not satiated, and wished to eat more.
- After finishing the meals we sat for sometime, then we got up to ask the person's permission to leave.

• Asbag bin Nabatah says: I saw my leader Amirul Momineen (a.s.) standing at the gate of Kufa looking towards the desert. It appeared that he was busy talking with some one but there was no one. I also stood up. After a long time I felt tired. So I sat down and got up again after a while. But Ali (a.s) was still busy talking. I went a step forward and asked: O Amirul Momineen! Who is it you are talking with?



 He said: This talk of mine was to please the spirits of the faithful. I asked: Which faithful. No one from those who have passed away is present here. He said: Yes, they are present here I again asked: They are present here physical or in spirit?

 He replied: They are in spirit. Had you been able to do so, you could have seen how they gather at a place, talk mutually and please one another

remembering the gifts and bounties of God.

PROOF OF TORTURE IN BARZAKH

 Their cries are heard by all except men and jinns. Such voices shock animals and they stop taking food etc.



MAKING FUN OF OTHERS

- ome would fall in dark and deep wells and as they would fall, huge flames would emerge.
- I asked Haadi, "Who are these wells for?"
- "They are meant for people who laugh at other faithfuls and make fun of them, whether through words hints, gestures, making faces, eye-movements etc. This is their destination. As God has said, "Hell is for the faultfinders and insulters." As for those who are eating carcasses, they were the backbiters. And the ones with flaming ears, they used to listen to others backbiting. And these dogs, wolves and cats fighting each other used to curse, blame and insult each other. And those with yellow faces and two tongues were the faultfinder, liars and complainers.

The Holy Prophet (sawa) said: "Verily the one with a good nature has the same reward as the one who fasts and prays during the night" Al-Kafi, v.2 p.100 no.5

IGNORANCE AS A COMPANION

Hadi leaves but another friend comes. I was happy that I had at last found a companion to lessen the loneliness of the journey.

- When he came close, I saw that he was quite ugly to look at and had a distressed look.


When I returned I saw that my mount was ready for the journey and Haadi was packing a portmanteau on it. I asked him where it had come from.

5) WEALTH OF ORPHAN

Those who take the wealth of the orphan and the usurers

Holy Prophet (saw) said: Next I saw a group of people into whose mouths angels were pouring fire and it was coming out of thie rear-ends.

- They had unrighteously consumed the property of orphans.
 - Then I passed a crowd of people who could not rise on account of their large stomachs. These were usurers.

7) ADULTERY—Land of Desire

- People in various forms of torture (hanging from privates, having fire there etc)

- LAND OF DESIRE-- LUST, HOMOSEXUALS

8) NEGLECTING NAMAZ

- I saw another group of people whose skulls were being crushed with rocks and whose brains were flowing out. I asked, Who are these people?
- Gibraeel said, These are the people who would go to sleep without having prayed Salat al Isha.

9) DESIRED HARAAM

Imam Baqir said: On the night of ascension Holy Prophet (saw) passed a company suspended by their feet on hooks of fire,

 because when the Most High had made them rich in lawful things, they desired what was unlawful.

10) ACCUSED OF ADULTERY

Imam Baqir (Said: Another company were having their mouths sewed up with needles and threads of fire because they had accused virgins.

STATION—allah gives shield



His making fun of me angered me. Though I was weak I started to fight. But he was stronger and I could see that he was overpowering me. When I saw this involuntarily

- I started calling Hazrat Ali (A.S.) for help: "YA ALI MADAD". No sooner had I said this, all the machines which had been about to crush me, suddenly started a disorderly retreat and in the process crashed into each other, breaking into pieces
- Darky too tried to run away, but was crushed under the wheels of a giant roller.
- I said, "Wretched person, you were making fun of me. Now you are in the same boat that I was in. And nobody deserves it more then you do." This was my last encounter with Darky.

I managed to come back to the Main Road, which was the straight road and the correct path. It had only been Darky's mischief that my mount had gone astray.

as moms we need to be like Him so our kids have hope in forgiveness from Him

WHAT IS FORGIVENESS

"I seek the forgiveness of God."

The Imam said to him:

"May your mother weep for you! Do you know what it is to seek the forgiveness of God? Seeking forgiveness of God is the station of those of high rank. It appears to be but a word, but it includes six aspects.

- 1) The first is regret for what has been done;
- 2) the second is firm resolve to abandon sinning in future;
- the third is restoring to others whatever rights of theirs you may have usurped, in such a
 way that when you meet your Creator they will have no claim in you;
- the fourth is that you perform whatever obligatory acts of worship you may have neglected;
- the fifth is that you cleanse with the tears of regret the illicit flesh that grew on your body while you were sinning;
- 6) and the sixth is that just as you tasted the pleasure of sin and disobedience, you now taste the hardship and rigor of worship and obedience.

Only when you have completed all of these six may you say, 'I seek forgiveness of God.'" (Nahj al-Balagha, ed. Subhi Salih, p. 549)



THE POOL OF KAUTHAR IN BARZAKH TOO

Abdullah bin Sinan is quoted in several books of traditions and narrations.

- He asked Imam Sadiq (a.s.) about the Pool of Kauthar (a heavenly spring).
- He replied, "Its length is equal to the distance between Basra and Yemen (Sana)." When he
 expressed his astonishment he asked, "May I show it to you?"
- I said, "Yes, 0 my Master!" Then the Imam took him out of Medina.
- There he kicked the ground on one spot and said, "See!" (Veils before his eyes were removed by the order of the Imam. He says,
- "I saw a huge spring flowing, the shores of which were not visible except the spot on which we stood and which was like a small island.
- I saw a spring at one bank of which <u>SNOW WHITE WATER WAS FLOWING IN</u>
 WAVES AND ON THE OTHER BANK WHITER THAN SNOW MILK
 FLOWING AND IN BETWEEN THE TWO, FLOWED WINE, WHICH
 HAD FINE RED colour that was more attractive than topaz both in sheen and fineness.
- I had never before seen such a wine of the best quality flowing between pure milk and snow white water."

I said, "O Master! May I be sacrificed on you. From where does this spring flow?" The Imam replied, "As mentioned by Almighty God in the Holy Quran, there is a spring of milk, a spring of water and a spring of wine in paradise. All these three springs come from there."

Houri near kauther

- The narrator says, "I saw many trees on both the banks of this spring and a houri near every tree.
- She had such beautiful hair the like of which I had never seen before.
- There was a utensil in the hands of every houri. The said vessels were so beautiful that I had
 never seen such utensils in the world. They did not belong to this material world. He hinted to a
 houri to serve water.
- She filled that utensil from that spring and presented it to the Imam. He drank from it. He asked her again to fill it. She complied with the command and the Imam gave that utensil to me.

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- I drank from it and found that I had never tasted such a nice, delicious and pleasing drink ever before. It had a fragrance of musk.
- I said, 'May I be sacrificed on you. Whatever I observed today is such that I had not only never seen before but also never even imagined before, (that such things could ever be available in the world)."
- The Imam said, "What you have seen is only a small specimen of the bounties provided by God Almighty for our Shias.
- When somebody leaves the world his or her spirit is taken to this stream and around this garden
 of paradise. He eats its fruits and drinks its wines.
- Whenever our enemy dies, his soul is being taken to Wadi-eBarhoot. He remains in its torture forever. He is forced to eat 'Zaqqoom' (a thorny cactus tree) and drink hot hell water. So pray to God for being protected from the said Barhoot valley.".



BRIDGE OF SERAT (POOLE SERAT)

Hadith e kudsi

- 1) O, Son of Adam! every day of your life is getting shorter, but still you do not understand?
- Each day I send down to you My bounties, but you are not thankful to Me for them. You are not content with little nor are you satisfied with much.
- O, Son of Adam! not a single day misses but that your provision comes to you from Me; and not a single night passes, but that My angles give Me accounts of your bad deeds.
- 4) You eat My provision, and you still disobey Me; but still when you call Me, I still answer you.
- 5) From Me, good bounties descend upon you and from you. And from you, sinful deeds come up to Me. How good a master I am and how bad a servant you are!
- 6) I give you what ever you ask Me, but still you go on sinning. I hide these sins, one after another, one evil deed after another. I am ashamed of you, but you are not ashamed of Me?
- 7) You forget Me, but I remember you.

8) You are <u>afraid of people</u>, and you are careless of Me. You fear enmity of people, but you do not fear My wrath?

The bridge of sirat (From Mahshar to Janna over Jahannam)

- Serat' in the grammatical sense means a way or a road, and it's meaning according to the Shari'ah is a bridge or a road which passes from the top of hell.
- In a tradition from Ma'soom (A.S.) it is stated that 'Poole Serat' is a bridge thinner than a hair, sharper than a sword, and hotter than fire (of this world).
- The true believers (Mo'meneen) will pass over it speedily like lightening.
- Some will find some difficulty over it, but will later find relief.
- While there will be some who will slip and fall down in the pit of hell.
- The likeness of 'Poole Serate' is of "The Right Path (Seratal Mustaqeem) of this world, the path of Ali (A.S.) and Aimmah (A.S.)'s obedience.
- The person who in this world turned away from the `Seratal Mustaqeem' (The path of Ahlulbait) in word and deed, and was attracted towards falsehood, on the day of Qayamat he will slip over the Poole Serat and fall into hell.
- In Surah-al-Hamd, Seratal Mustageem' refers to both these paths (The path of Ahlulbait and Poole Serat).

HOW WE WILL REACH POOLEY SIRAT



"And hell is made to appear on that day" (Surah-al-Fajr: 23)


Imam Mohammad-al-Baqir (A.S.) says, that when the verse (Ayah) was revealed, the Holy prophet(S.A.W.S.) was asked regarding its interpretation.

- He replied, "Jibra'eel has informed me that when Allah will have gathered everyone from the beginning to the end on the day of Qayamat,
- one thousand Angels will bring the hell pulling it with a thousand ropes with great difficulty.
- Hell will be roaring and raging with anger and the voice of breaking (of bones) will be heard from it.
- At that moment a ferocious voice will erupt from it, which Allah has reserved to take the account of people, and every one will perish (with fear).
- Men, Angels, and the Prophet will be wailing with fright
- Man will cry out, "Our Lord! save me, save me",
- while the Prophets will cry out, "O Lord! save my people (ummah)".
- So each Prophet will take account from Their people (ummah) and walk over the Poole Serat.
- No one will have any escape from walking over it.
- Allah says in the Qur'an:

And there is not one of you but shall come to it, this is an unavoidable decree of your Lord. And we will deliver those who guarded (against evil,) and we will leave the unjust therein on their knees".

(Surah-al -Maryam: 71-72)"".

Allamah Majlisi in his book 'Haqqul Yaqeen' quotes from Shaikh Sadooq that:



Our belief concerning Qayamat is that the Passes (Aqabaat) have each a specific name.

PASSES ARE 3 TYPES:

- some are called Farz (compulsory Acts),
- · others Amr (Commands),
- yet others Nahy (Prohibitions).

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- So when a man will reach the Pass of Farz, and he had neglected it (in his life), he will be stopped there and
- imprisoned for a <u>thousand years</u>, and the dues of Allah will be demanded of him.
- Now if he goes out of it by means of some good act performed by him in the world, or by the Mercy of Allah, then he escapes from it and goes on to another Pass.
- He will not cease to be sent from one Pass to another, and be stopped and questioned regarding his shortcomings in respect of each stage.

IF HE IS STOPPED

- And if he is stopped at a Pass, and
- is questioned about a certain due in respect of which he is found wanting, and
- neither a good action on his part
- nor the Mercy of Allah reaches him,
- HIS STEP WILL STUMBLE AND HE WILL BE HURLED DOWN IN THE FIRE OF HELL.



IF HE PASSES OVER THE PASSES


- If he escapes safely from all the Passes, he will arrive at the abode of Permanence (Darul Baqa).
- Here he comes upon everlasting life, and perpetual beautitude, without any affliction what so ever.
- He will reside in the neighbourhood of Allah, with the Prophets (A.S.), and the Imam (A.S.),
- the veracious ones, the Martyres (Shohada), and the righteous ones from among His slaves.

ONE WAY TO MAKE POOLEY SIRAT EASY

**KHUTBA SHABANIYA—prophet s.a.w—one of the ways to make pooley sirat easy is to IMPROVE MANNERS IN RAMADHAN

Passing #1: kindness (Sile Raham), Trust (Amanah), Love of Ahlulbait (A.S.) (Walayah).

- KINDNESS: The first station here is of kindness (Sile Rahm).
- The Holy Qur'an admonishes us in the following words: "And be careful of (your duty to) Allah, by whom you demand one of another (your rights), and to the ties of relationship". (Surah- an- Nisa: 1)



So when one of your relatives is sick visit him, if he is indigent help him and fulfil his wants, and visit them (your relatives) on important days (of Idd etc.).

 WEALTH NOTHING IN RELATION TO SILEY REHM REWARD

IMAM ALI A.S: DO GOOD WHILE YOU CAN, WHILE YOU ARE HEALTHY

- "O servants of God, prepare yourselves now to work good.
 For your tongues suffer no impediment, your bodies are
 sound, and limbs are obedient. The field of action is open
 before all of you." (Nahj al-Balagha, sermon 191)
- Imam Mohammad -al- Baqir (A.S.) that one day someone gave the good news to Abu zarr that his sons had brought a huge stock of cattle, and that his Property had increased.
- To which Abu zarr replied, "The increase-ment of property will not make me happy, nor do I consider it to be a prosperity for I believe in being moderate and little is sufficient for me.
- The guarding of this property would have made me busy and being negligent (of my duty towards Allah).
- I have heard the Messenger of Allah (S.A.W.S.) as saying that, on the day of Qayamat when a person who is trustworthy and kind passes over the poole Serat'
- The same kindness and trust will be on both the sides to support him.



KINDNESS TO PARENTS

- The person who in this world is not merciful towards his parents will have a short life.
- · He will not prosper (in wealth), and
- in the Hereafter will be stopped on the first station on poole Serat, and no mercy will be shown towards him.

The second station is of Trust (Amanah).

- · Trust does not only include wealth,
- but also if someone confides in you and tells a secret requesting you not to reveal it to anyone, this too is included in trust. If you disclose it to another, you have committed breach of trust. If you disgrace someone, you have committed breach.
- And also if someone keeps some wealth with you as a trust and even after promising to return it, you refuse to do so, you are said to have committed breach (of trust).
- The same rule applies for hire. If you borrowed something from someone for a fixed period, after the period having expired you do not return it, it will be deemed as being a VIOLATION OF TRUST.

OATEY REHM AND BREAKING OF TRUST

- It is also related that the person who has committed
- · breach of trust or severed relations with his kith a kin,
- on the day of Qayamat when he will walk over the poole Serat,
- · none of his deeds will be of any help to him, and


he will fall flat into the pit of hell.

HAZRAT LUQMAN--WHY WAS HE GIVEN THIS?

- They relates that once a stranger passed by Luqman alaihissalam while he was sitting among his followers.
- The man said, addressing Luqman, "Aren't you the bondman of such and such tribe"? He replied, "Yes, I was a slave boy of that tribe".
- The stranger asked again, "Aren't you the one who used to graze the goats near such and such hill?" Luqman replied, "Yes, I am the same person".
- The man said, 'Then what has brought you to this noble position?"
- "A man came to Luqman, the wise and asked: Are you Luqman? Are you the slave of so and so? He said: "Yes!" The man said: You are the black shepherd! Luqman said: As for my black color, it is obviously apparent, so what makes you so astonished?
- Luqman alaihissalam replied, "I was very particular about a few things and I observed them on all occasions, viz.

The man said: You became frequently visited by the people who pleasingly accept your judgments! Luqman said:

- 0 cousin! If you do what I am telling you, you will be like this.
- The man said: What is it?



- · Luqman said:
- Lowering my gaze,
- · watching my tongue,
- · eating what is lawful,
- keeping my chastity,
- undertaking my promises,
- fulfilling my commitments,
- being hospitable to guests,
- · respecting my neighbors, and
- discarding what does not concern me.
- fear of Allah Ta'ala,
- truthfulness in speech,
- fulfilling a trust and
- avoiding useless talk."
- All these made me the one you are looking at."

The third station is of Love of Ahlulbait (A.S.) (Walayah).

"And stop them, for they shall be questioned". (Surah- al-Saffat: 24).

 Regarding the love of Ahlulbait (A.S.) many traditions have been quoted in the Shi'ah as well as Sunni books, that Walayah means the Love of Imam Ali (A.S.). It is said that people will be stopped



- and asked if they accepted the walayah' of Imam Ali (A.S.) in the world and said, "Aliyyun Waliyullah", while believing in it.
- Allamah Huwainee and Tabari both great scholars of the Ahle Sunnat quote the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) as saying
- O' Ali! Whoever denies your love will be stopped (from going further) over the poole Serat".
- whoever has got the passport of the Love of Ali (A.S.) will pass easily over the Serat.

Passing #2:Namaz.(Salaat)

 Allah says in the Qur'an, "Woe to the praying ones, who are unmindful of their prayers". (Surah- al-Ma'oon: 4-5).

On this pass a person will be stopped and questioned regarding the

- · five daily prayers,
- · the prayer of Signs (Namaze Ayaat), and
- elapsed prayers (Namaze Qaza), about which it has been discussed in the chapter of "Accounting"
- Imam Ja'far- as-Sadiq (A.S.) in his last will said "Whoever considering Namaz to be unimportant (or lowly) will not receive our Intercession (in Qayamat)".
- The person who does not offer Namaz dies thirsty, and will also arise thirsty from his grave.

OUR GOOD DEEDS HELP OUR PARENTS

"O' you who believe! save your selves and your families from a fire whose fuel is men and stones". (Surah- at Tahreem: 6)

Then we should warn our relatives and friends (from the wrath of Allah) by

- · enjoining good (Amr bil Ma'roof) and
- · forbidding evil (Nahy anil Munkar).
- People should themselves recite Namaz &) advice others to do so.
 We should adapt our children to offer Namaz because parents of a child reciting Namaz too get a share in their rewards.
- Once a Prophet was passing from near a grave with his
 companions, when suddenly he told them to pass away quickly for
 the person in the grave was being chastised by Allah's wrath. One
 year later when he passed by that same grave, he sensed that the
 wrath of Allah had been lifted up from the grave. He was
 astonished and asked Allah the reason for it. Allah relied, "This
 person had left behind him a child who was sent to school, his
 teacher taught him to recite "Bismillahir Rahmanir Raheem".
- Thus when his child addressed Me as being a Beneficent and Merciful Lord, I forgave his parents, for they have been a medium for his birth.
- "I felt ashamed that in spite of their child addressing me thus, I should punish them".

PASSING #3:ZAKAAT.

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GIVE CHARITY OR U WILL REGRET

Spend in the path of God a part of the sustenance We have bestowed on you, before death overtakes you. Then the sinner will say, `O Lord, if You were to grant me a respite and postpone my death a little, I would certainly do good and become one of The virtuous'". (63:10).

- If a person in his life has not paid zakat or khums due on him (even equal to a dirham) to the deserving persons will be stopped at this pass.
- Many harsh words have been used regarding the non payment of khums, and many traditions are found regarding it. One tradition needs to be quoted here from usool e kafi that Imam Ja'far- as-Sadiq (A.S.) says that on the day of Qayamat the most difficult time will be when the deserving person of khums will catch hold of the end of the shirt of the one who did not pay it. They will ask for their right from them on this pass, and will not allow him to move further until he gives them their due rights. But the situation will become even worse when the Interceders (Ahlulbait) themselves will ask for Their Rights (khums) from people.
- · It is also related that when Imam- al- Mahdi (A.T.F.S.) reappears,
- · He shall put to death those who do not pay zakat due on them.
- The person hoards large provisions of gold and silver (will zakat due on them), on the day of Qayamat
- these dirhams and dinars will be made red hot in fire and will be placed on their foreheads and their sides.
 As said in the Qur'an, "on the day when it shall be heated in the fire of hell, then their foreheads and their sides and their backs shall be branded with it, this is what you hoarded up for



yourselves, therefore taste what you hoarded". (Surah- al - Bara'at: 35) There is no difference between the Zakat of wealth and the Zakat of body (Fitrah).

CHARITY

Imam Ja'far -as- Sadiq (A.S.) that He said, that on the day of Qayamat two types of people from the followers of Ahlulbait (A.S.) will have to wait for long.

- One will be the indigent and poor person, while other a rich and wealthy person.
- The poor man will cry out, "O my Lord why do I have to wait so long. I swear by your Glory and Majesty that in the world you had given me no kingdom or empire so that I may oppress anyone or commit injustice therein or usurp other's rights.
- And you had given me only that which You thought was enough for me, and I remained patient and never grumbled. Then Allah will reply, "O believer surely you speak the truth", THUS HE WILL BE MADE TO ENTER PARADISE.
- The <u>RICH MAN</u> will have to wait so long that he will sweat profusely, so much so that forty camels could quench their thirst with it. Only then will he be made to enter paradise.
- In paradise when they will meet each other, the poor man will ask him the reason for having made to wait so long.
- The rich man will reply, "I was made to wait for a long time giving account of my enormous wealth, so to how I earned it (whether



- lawfully or unlawfully), as how I spent it. Then the merciful Lord blessed me, forgave my sins and accepted my repentance".
- Then he will ask the poor man as to who he was? He will reply that
 he is the same indigent fellow who was with him in the plains of
 Qayamat. The rich man will say, "Verily the blessings and
 bounties of paradise have transformed you to such an extent that
 even I could not recognize you". (matalib)
- The fourth group will consist of people whose bad deeds will be more than their good ones. And only if Allah's mercy, blessings and forgiveness will give way, they will be made to enter paradise. If not they will be punished at that very place, the punishment appropriate for them. They will be chastised in that way till they become clean of all sins. Then people in whose hearts even an atoms weight of faith (Eeman) exists, will not have to stay long in hell, they will be brought back to paradise. While only the polytheists and unbelievers will remain there.

NAHJUL BALAGHA SERMON 21 KEEP LIGHT AND OVERTAKE

Your aim (reward or punishment) is before you.

- · Behind your back is the hour (of resurrection) which is driving you on.
- Keep (yourself) light and overtake (the forward ones).
- Your last ones are being awaited by the first ones (who have preceded).

"Keep light and overtake" is the shortest expression ever heard with the greatest sense conveyed by it.

Passing #4:Fasting(Saum).



- · On the fourth pass people will be questioned regarding fasting.
- If a person has been fasting in this world, only then shall he be permitted to pass over it easily, otherwise he shall be stopped there.
- The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) has said, "FASTS ACT AS A SHIELD AGAINST THE FLAMES OF THE FIRE OF HELL".
- The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) has said, "For the one who fasts there are two good tidings for him, one at the time of breaking the fast (Iftaar), while the second when he shall meet his Lord.
- He will then pass over the poole Serat easily and enter the presence of his Almighty.
- It is related that whoever fasts for six days in the month of Rajab will find peace in Qayamat, and will walk over the poole serat easily without been accounted.

Passing #5:Pilgrimage (Hajj)

- If the performance of Hajj becomes obligatory (wajib) on a person in his life-time, and he does not perform it, then he shall be stopped at this pass.
- It is stated that during death it will be said unto him "You have died the death of a <u>Jew or a Christian</u>. You are not associated with Islam.
- It is said in the Qur'an, "And pilgrimage to the House is incumbent upon men for the sake of Allah, (upon) everyone who is able to undertake the journey to it, and whoever disbelieves, then surely Allah is Self-sufficient, above any need of the world". (Surah-al-Aale Imraan: 96)

LET US DO OUR WAJIBAT BEFORE IT IS TOO LATE

· Imam al-Sadiq, peace be upon him, similarly said:

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"The life of man does not amount to more than an instant. What is past is now non-existent; you do not feel its pleasure or pain. As for what is yet to come, you do not know what it is.

"The true and precious capital of your life are those few instants you presently enjoy. Master, then, your soul, and strive to redeem yourself and attain salvation; be steadfast in enduring the rigor of worshipping God and obeying His commandments; and preserve your self from the pollution of sin and disobedience to God."

Passing # 6:Cleanliness(Taharah).

- According to Ibne Abbas purification (Taharah) is of three types
- Ablution (Wuzu'),
- · Bath (Ghusl), and
- Tayammum, while others consider it to be <u>absolute purification</u> (of the body as well as the soul).
- If a person does not take care of cleanliness (or purification), specially those men and women who do not perform the ceremonial bath (<u>Ghusle Janabat</u>) correctly or on it prescribed time, shall be stopped at this pass.
- Women should also take care about the performance of other baths (viz. Qhusle Haiz, Nifaas, Iztahaza etc.), and not be negligent about it as is the custom amongst. ignorant people.
- It is related that a person who does not keep himself away from impurities, he will face the squeeze in the grave.

Passing #7: Rights (Mazalim).


 Mazalim is sometimes <u>INTERPRETED AS JUSTICE</u> while sometimes it refers to <u>THE RIGHTS OF OTHERS</u>.

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- The Holy Qur'an says about this pass: ".Most surely your Lord is watching". (Surah-al-Fajr: 14)
- In interpretation of this verse Lord is said that some people will be passing over the poole Serat in a manner that they will be clasping it by their hands.
- Others will be walking in manner that one leg of their's will be slipping and they will be taking help of their second leg, while the Angels will be standing on both sides.
- People will be falling into the fire of hell like bats (falling on the ground).
- The person who is fortunate to get the Mercy and Blessings of Allah will pass over the poole Serat easily and will say, "All praise be to Allah, for verily He has completed my good deeds with His Mercy and Blessings and increased my reward. I thank Him that He with His Beneficence and kindness gave me freedom, when I had lost all hope".
- Without doubt Allah is the forgiver of sins of His servants and the rewarder of their good deeds.
- If a person has <u>troubled someone with no fault of his</u>, he will be imprisoned for FIVE HUNDRED YEARS ON THIS PASS so much so that his bones will break.
- If a person has usurped someone's wealth, he will be imprisoned for FORTY YEARS ON THIS PASS and then he shall be thrown into the fire of hell.
- In traditions it is narrated that in exchange for one (usurped)
 dirham, seven thousand (accepted) prayers of the usurper will be
 given to the person whose dirham he acquired.

Incident.

Allamah Bahauddin Sayyed Ali bin Abdul karim Neeli Najafi (whatever praise of his is done will be quite less, who was the student of Shaikh Shaheed), in his book ANWARUL MAZIYYAH (written in praise of Imam Ali) narrates an incident from his father who says that: In Neela (a village in Abaee) there lived a



person who was the superintendent of the Mosque. One day he did not come out of his house, when people called him he excused himself. People inquired about it and they found out that his entire body was charred except his thighs, and he was groaning with pain and sorrow. When people asked him how he burnt himself he replied that, "I dreamt that Qayamat has dawned, and people are in anguish because majority of them are been thrown into hell, while a small minority will be going towards paradise. I was among those who were going towards paradise".

"Suddenly I reached a large and lengthy bridge which was referred to as poole Serat. I started walking on it, and as much as I walked its breadth became narrow and its length increased until I reached a place where it turned sharper than a sword. Beneath was a large valley full of black and roaring fire whose flames were spurting out like large mountain peaks. Some people walked away easily while some slipped and fell down. And I was so much scared that I had no other wish except to cross the bridge rapidly. Suddenly I reached that place where I could no longer control myself and I fell head-long into the pit of the blazing fire. Its pit had no end and the fire pulled me down. I could not even scream and my mind went blank, and I reached down equal to the distance of seventy years. Suddenly I was inspired and I called out "O Ali ibne Abi Talib! O Amiral Mo'meneen! help me my Lord". At that moment I saw a person standing on the edge of the valley. I recognized him to be no other than my Master Ali (A.S.). I called out to Him and He commanded me to extend my hand. I did so and He pulled me out of the blazing fire. Then He (A.S.) started extinguishing the fire from my thighs with His blessed hands. I suddenly woke up from my dream and found that my whole body was burnt, except my thighs where my Master had laid His hands". This person treated his wounds for three months and was cured.

Now whenever I relate this incident to anyone, he develops fever (due to fear), while only some remain unaffected.


Those A'mal which Prove helpful to pass over the poole serat easily.

(1) Sayyed ibne Tawoos in his book Iqbal relates that whoever recites

- twenty units (Rak'at) of prayers after Namaze Maghrib on the night of the first of Rajab,
- such that in each Rak'at after <u>Surab-al-Hamd recites once Surah-al-Tawheed</u>,
- then he and his family will be saved from the punishment in the grave, and will cross the poole Serat like lightening without any accounting.

MONTH OF SHABAAN

- a person who recites ten units of Namaz on the night of twenty ninth Sha'ban,
- such that in each unit after <u>Surah-al-Hamd recites ten times</u>
 <u>Surah-at-Takasur</u>, <u>Surah-an-Naas</u>, <u>Surah-al-Falaq</u>, <u>Surah-al-kaferoon</u>, and <u>Surah-at-Tawheed</u> each,
- Allah will give him reward
- · equal to theologians, and will
- increase his good deeds,
- will ease his accounting, and he will
- cross the poole Serat like lightening.
- IMAM RAZA A.S
 As discussed in the earlier mailis,
- that whoever goes for pilgrimage to the shrine of Imam Ali-ar-Reza (A.S.),
- Imam (A.S.) Himself comes for his rescue (in Qayamat) at <u>three</u>
 <u>different places and saves him from the terrors of that day one</u>
 <u>of which is the Bridge of Serat'</u>.



TAME NAFS, BEAUTIFY THE SOUL

Imam al-Sadiq, upon whom be peace, said:

"Restrain your soul from what harms it before death overtakes you.

Strive to keep your soul free in just the same way that you strive to earn your livelihood. For your soul is hostage to your deeds, and only your efforts can set it free."

TAMING OF OURSELVES

The Commander of the Faithful, upon whom be peace, said,

"Tame your rebellious and transgressing soul by abandoning the habit of sin; compel it to obey God's commands; and impose on it the burden of compensating for its violations. Then adorn it with moral and spiritual virtues and keep it free from the pollution of sin."



DAY OF JUDGEMENT

It is narrated through many great personalities, that when the dead men where raised back to life by them, they saw that their hair had turned gray. They asked them the reason. To which they replied that, "When we were told to arise, we thought that Qayamat had come, and our hair turned grey due to it's fright".

WE WILL DIE IN OUR TRACKS

The Most Noble Messenger, peace and blessings be upon him and his family, said:


"At that time, some people will be in their own homelands, and

- No one who has a soul will remain, except his heart be stripped bare while he mentions his sins and is occupied with his soul, except as Allah wishes.
- Then, where will you be, Amr at this"?
- "Indeed I am hearing of a terrible event", said Amr.
- Then he believed in Allah and His Apostle. People from his tribe also accepted Islam and returned back.

ten A'amals which eases the FEARS, troubles and difficulties of Qayamat:

- It is related that a person who recites <u>Surah-al-Yusuf daily</u> during the day or night, will arise
 on the day of Qayamat with the likeness of the beauty of Prophet Yusuf (A.S.), and will be saved
 from the FEAR OF QAYAMAT.
- Imam Mohammad al-Baqir (A.S.) says that a person who recites <u>Surah-ad-Dukhan</u> in <u>Nafela</u> <u>Prayers or obligatory (Wajib)</u> Namaz, will remain safe from the FEAR OF QAYAMAT.
- 3) Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) says that a person who recites <u>Surah al-Ahqaf</u> on the day or night on friday, will be safe from all fears of this world as well as the hereafter.
- 4) In another tradition Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) says that a person who recites Surah-al-Asr in Supererogatory (Nafela) Prayers, will arise in DELIGHT on the day of Qayamat.
 - His face will be glowing, and his eyes shining, and he will enter Paradise in this cheerful state.
- 5) Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) who says that the Holy Prophet Mohammad (S.A.W.S.) said, that whoever respects a man with a white beard, Allah will grant him refuge from the fear of the day of Qayamat. (respect age of someone)



6) The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) says, that whoever dies <u>WHILE GOING TO MECCA OR</u> <u>RETURNING</u> from there, will be saved by Allah from the fear of the day of Qayamat.

Shaikh Sadooq quotes the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) as saying that whoever **dies or BURIED** n the <u>courtyard of the Ka'abah or Masjide Nabawi (in Medina)</u>, will arise in a manner that he will be free from all terror and fear.

7) Shaikh Sadooq narrates from the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) that He said, if a person guards HIMSELF FROM SINS OR THE LUSTFUL PASSIONS (OF HIS SELF), only for the sake and fear of Allah, Allah will make the fire of hell forbidden upon him and keep him away from the fear of Qayamat.

The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) says that Allah will grant refuge from the fear of Qayamat to the man who keeps away from the PASSIONS OF HIS SELF.

- 8) Imam Mohammad al-Baqir (A.S.) who said that whoever suppresses his anger even after having power (to retaliate), Allah will fill his heart with faith (Eeman), and save him from the terror of Oayamat.
- 9) Imam Ali-ar-Reza (A.S.) that whoever goes to the grave of a believer brother, places his hand on it and RECITES SURAH-AL-QADR SEVEN TIMES, Allah will keep him away from the troubles of Qayamat.

10) LOVE OF ALI A.S

One of the reasons for a person to be free from the fear of Qayamat is the Love (Walayah) of Ali (A.S.).

The Holy Prophet Mohammad (S.A.W.S.) said, "O Ali You and Your Shiahs will remain under the <u>protection on the day of Qayamat</u>, and the (above mentioned) verse (Ayah) bears witness to it".

- Whoever dies bearing love of Ahlulbait (A.S.) will become pure after repentance, and when he shall arise on the day of Qayamat,
- · a cloud will give shelter on his head, and
- · he will remain safe from the terror of Qayamat and
- · enter Paradise in this manner.

Allah will offer him SEVENTY TWO types of favours (ne'mat).

- . One of them is that He will increase his sustenance (Rizq) in this world, and
- seventy one are that He will guard him against the terrors and hardships of Qayamat.

6th Imam said: walking etc to help a believer is like walking between safa and Marwa in hajj

Ja'far as-Sadiq (A.S.) says <u>FULFILLING</u> a brother believer's wishes is greater than the performance of Haj, Haj (and repeated it ten times. It means that it is greater than the performance of ten Haj).

HELPING BELIEVERS

Many traditions (Ahadees) have been narrated in praise of fulfilling a believer brother's wishes.

- Imam Mohammad al-Baqir (A.S.) says that, "If a mo'min goes to fulfill the desires of his brother believer,
- Allah orders the angels to give SHADE OF SEVENTY THOUSAND VEILS OVER HIS HEAD, and
- before he steps out (to go for help) Allah writes down many virtues in his deed-sheet".
 Imam

- Holy Prophet, 4 things will help us on the day of Qayamat will be the following four qualities:
- (1) To fondle with affection the head of an orphan (yatcem),
- · (2) To Show kindness towards widows,
- . (3) To go to fulfill the wishes of a believer brother, and
- (4) to take care of the poor and the needy

ZIYARAT OF IMAM RAZA A.S helps too

Allamah Majlisi narrates from Imam Ali ar-Reza (A.S.) in 'Tohfatus Saemeen' that He said,

"Whoever comes to visit my grave from far and near, on the day of Qayamat

- We shall save him from THREE CALAMITIES:
- (1) We shall give him refuge from the <u>TERRORS OF QAYAMAT</u>, when the scrolls of good doers will be given in their right hands, and evil ones in their left hands,
- (2) He will be safe from the punishment at the BRIDGE (POOL) OF SERAT,
- (3) During WEIGHING OF SCALES We will help him".

re: SHAFAT-IMAM RAZA a.s

- * the eighth Imam, Raza (A.S.) said: "We do not have a permit to free any one from the flames of Hell. And our intercession cannot overcome Divine Justice. One who is obedient to Allah is our friend, and the one who is disobedient is our foe". This shows that a claim of love and friendship of Ahlebait will hold only WHEN BACKED WITH DEEDS, which are according to Ahlebait's wishes and desires.
- Otherwise to continue <u>leading a life bereft of good deeds and even</u> <u>indulge in evil and then to depend upon the love of Ahlebait is to</u> <u>deceive oneself.</u>)

"Today is the day of work, not the day of resting" (Nahj al-Balagha, sermon 42)

(Imam says do not sleep right now and feel you should be relaxing, the time to relax and enjoy is in afterlife)

THE CONFESSIONAL

SKIN WILL GIVE WITNESS (gawahi)

When they enter hellfire, their eyes and ears and the skins on their bodies shall give witness against them on account of the sins they have committed. They will address their skins asking them, 'Why do you give witness against us?' They will receive this answer: 'The Lord Who gave speech to all things and Who first created you has given speech to us, too; certainly you will return to him.'" (41:20-21)

BODY PARTS WILL SPEAK

65This Day, We shall seal up their mouths, and their hands will speak to Us, and their legs will bear witness to what they used to earn. (sura yaseen 65)

WE WILL RECITE OUR OWN SINS

On that day man shall become aware of all the deeds, good and evil, he has committed through out his life" (75:13).

THE BOOK OF DEEDS (neemay amaal)

Inna nahnu nuhyee almawta wanaktubu ma qaddamoo waatharahum wakulla shay-in ahsaynahu fee imamin mubeenin

Verily we shall give life to the dead, and we record that which they send before and that which they leave behind, and of all the things we have taken account in a clear book of evidence

Woe Upon us! What kind of a book is this that records and enumerates with precision all of our deeds, great and small?"

The verse then proceeds: "They shall see all of their deeds, present before them, and God shall not wrong anyone" (18:49).

Someone once asked Imam al-Sadiq, upon whom be peace,

"Does man know what he will see in his record of deeds?"

The Imam replied: "God Almighty will remind him of them, so that there will be no closing of an eye, no taking of a step, no uttering a word, that he will not remember; it will be as if he had done all that the moment before.

FORGIVENESS OF SINS, DIGNITY OF SERVANT

- -a man came to 6th Imam in medina "i have to tell u something"
- -imam said meet me in mecca
- -imam then said meet me in mina
- -he says he has committed a sin and wants to confess
- -Imam says I was avoiding you so you would reconsider, for it is between u and god. On day of Judgement, there will be some who allah will see in private, where the confession will take place in private.
 - And yes, we see in quran that He will take their sins and transform them into sawaab!
 That is the justice of allah s.w.t
 - So these are they of whom Allah changes their evil deeds into good ones (quran 25:70)

THE ONE WHO WILL BE HUMILIATED

Imam Hussein a.s (that prophet said):

O community of those hwo have believed with their tongues but not with their hearts. Do not seek the shortcomings of believers and do not try to uncover their faults. Most surely, one who seeks to uncover the faults of his brother, allah will disclose his faults; and for whomsoever allah discloses his faults, he will disgrace him even if it be within his own home.

Imam Hussein: one who narrates something concerning a believer with the intention of disgracing and defaming him, allah will humiliate him on the day of resurrection <u>UNLESS HE</u> <u>UNSAYS!</u>

Imam Ali A.S

Allah does not accept actions of one who hastens to blame a believer for his faults. And he does not accept actions from a believer whilst he harbours evil in his heart against another. If the veils were to be lifted from people, they would have seen what bond there is between allah and a believer and their necks would bow for the believers.

They would make the believers affairs easy and yield in their obedience. If they were to see the amount of actions being rejected from the heavens they would have said "allah will not accept any action from anyone"

(huggugallah and huggugunas)

MERITS OF SALAWAT—FOR DAY OF JUDGEMENT

The best actions which help to increase the measure of **good deeds in the scales in Qayamat**, are sending salawat on Mohammad (S.A.W.S.) and his progeny, and **good character**.

Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) and Imam Mohammad-al-Baqir (A.S.) that he said, "For increasing the measure of good deeds in the scales (meezan), no other deed carries weight than sending Salawat on Mohammad (S.A.W.S) and His progeny.

 Holy Prophet s.a.w A person's deeds will be weighed, and when his good deeds will seem less, I will bring along salawat which he sent upon me, and add to the good deeds thereby increasing their weight

HELPS DECREASE SINS (MAKES SCALE HEAVIER)

Imam Ali-ar-Reza (A.S.) that He said, that if a <u>person does not have the means to lessen the stock of his bad deeds</u>, he should send salawat and salaam on Mohammad (S.A.W.S.) and His progeny abundantly, **doing so will decrease (the weight of) his sins.**

Do it at least 3 times a day

Hazrat Mohammad (S.A.W.S.) said that if a person in my love and affection sends salawat on me thrice every day and night, it becomes the right on Allah that He should forgive his sins which he committed during the day and night.

TWO TYPES OF PEOPLE ON DAY OF J

- They will reside in gardens of eternity; they will be adorned with bracelets of gold and pearls, and their garments shall be of silk. They will say: 'Praise be to God who has removed all sorrow from us: in truth our Creator is merciful and just in dispensing reward. Out of His bounty He has settled us in an eternal abode of bliss; no toil or weariness shall touch us therein.'
- The abode of the unbelievers shall be hellfire there neither shall they die, nor shall their penalty be lightened; thus do We punish the unbelievers!
- They shall cry out, 'O Lord bring us forth from here so that we make work righteousness, not that which we used to do.'

THIRST, HUNGER AND CLOTHES ON DAY OF JUDGEMENT



Imam zainul abedin a.s:

- -whoever feeds a hungry believer, allah will feed him with the fruits of paradise
- -whoever gives a drink to a thirsty believer, allah will quench his thirst on day of judgement
- -whoever clothes a believer, allah will clothe him with a green robe of paradisc
- **whoever clothes a believe will remain under the security of allahs as long as a thread of the cloth remains

PROPHET ARRIVES

Wasilah is his pulpit, made of precious jewels and minerals, and very high. When it will be placed among the pulpits if other prophets, it will look like full moon among the stars.

'Liwa' means 'standard, flag', Liwa-ul-Hamd means 'StJuidard of 'Praise'. It is the personal standard of the Holy Prophet, given to him by Allah on the Day of Judgement. On it is written "There is none to be worshipped except Allah; Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah; the successful are only those who succeed by (Mercy of) Allah." It will be borne by Hadhrat Ali (A.S).

The Holy Prophet (S.A.W) will proceed towards his'Wa sil ah ', enwrapped in a robe of 'Nur' (Light), wearing the Crown of 'Power and Majesty'; and Ali' bin Abi Talib will be before him, carrying the Liwa-ul-Hamd.

The Standard of Praise (Liwaool Hamd):

Abdullah ibne Salam asked the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) regarding the Standard of praise (Liwaul Hamd) to be presented to him in Qayamat.

- He (S.A.W.S.) replied that, it's length is equal to the distance of a thousand years.
- It's pillars will be of red rubies, and it's handle of white pearls, while it's flag will be of green emeralds.
- · One flag will be swirling in the east,
- the second in the west,
- while the third one will be swirling in the middle.
- On it three sentences will be engraved, "In the Name of Allah, the Beneficent, Merciful", "All praise be to Allah the Lord of the worlds", and "There is no God



except Allah, Mohammad (S.A.W.S.) is the Messenger of Allah, and Ali (A.S.) is the friend of Allah".

- The length of each of these sentences will be equal to the length of a thousand years.
- Abdullah asked, "Who will be carrying this standard"? The Holy Prophet
 (S.A.W.S.) replied, "The same person who in this world is my Standard-bearer viz
 . Ali the son of Abu Talib (A.S.)".
- Abdullah replied, "verily you speak the truth. But also inform me as to who all will remain under the shelter of this standard".
- He (S.A.W.S.) replied, "<u>The believers (Mo meneen) friends Shi'ahs of Allah, my friends a Shiahs, and the friends and Shi'ahs of Ali</u> (A.S.).verily this position is very high. And Allah's wrath be on the one who believes me, or argues over his (Ali's exalted) creation by Allah".



Reaching the Wasila h, the Holy Prophet will ascend to its highest step, and Ali will sit just below him, carrying his standard. Then it will be announced: "This is my beloved Muhammad, and this is my Wali Ali bin Abi Talib;' Tu ba' (a tree in Paradise) is for him who loved him, and Wail' (Hell) is for him who held enmity towards him and told lies about him.

Then 'Ridhwan' (The keeper of Paradise) will present himself before the Holy Prophet and after Salam will say: "I am Ridhwan, the keeper of the Garden; My Lord has ordered me to bring to you the keys of the Gardens. So, please, accept them, O Muhammad!"

The Holy Prophet will say: "I accept it from Lord; to Him belongs the gratitude for all that He has Blessed me with: Give them to my brother Ali bin Abi Talib.

The keys will be given to Ali (A.S).



After that, Malik (The keeper of the Hell) will come and in the same way will present the keys of Hell to the Holy Prophet, who after thanking Allah, will order Malik to give it to Hadhrat Ali (AS).

Then Hadhrat Ali (A.S) will sit near Hell, and will tell it to "leave this man, because he is my follower and devottee, and take that man, he is my enemy."

And, in the words of the Holy Prophet (S.A.W), "Verily, Jahannam (Hell) on that Day will be the most obedient towards Ali; and it is because, verily, Ali (A.S) that Day is "Q ase em ul-Jannati-Wannar (The Distributor of the Garden and Fire).







- The Holy Prophet will say: "I accept it from Lord; to Him belongs the gratitude for all that He has Blessed me with: Give them to my brother Ali bin Abi Talib.
- The keys will be given to Ali (A.S).



- After that, MALIK (THE KEEPER OF THE HELL) will come and in the same way will present the keys of Hell to the Holy Prophet, who after thanking Allah, will order Malik to give it to Hadhrat Ali (AS).
- . Then I in turn will give the keys to Ali the son of Abu Talib (A.S.)
- [O Ali ! You are the distributor of Paradise and hell -- Holy Prophet].

"leave this man, because he is my follower and devotee, and take that man, he is my enemy."



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

SPRING/HAWZE KAUSER

- The existence of the Spring of Kausar is found in the Qur'an and the traditions,
- it is the abundance (Khayre Kaseer) which was bestowed on the Prophet (S.A.W.S.).



- Abdullah ibne Sinan asked Imam Ja'far -as- Sadiq (A.S.) regarding the Spring
 of Kausar. Imam (A.S.) replied that it's width is
- approximately equal to the distance from Basra in Iraq to Sanaa in Yemen.
 Abdullah seemed astonished.
- Then Imam Sadiq (A.S.) asked him, "Do you wish to have a glimpse of it?" He replied, "Yes O son of the Prophet!" Imam (A.S.) escorted him outside Madina, and struck his foot on the ground. Abdullah says that by the Imam's order the veils of the unseen were lifted off my eyes.
- I saw a stream flowing beneath, and the place where we were standing was surrounded by it.
- I saw on one side of the stream was flowing water which was
- whiter than ice, and
- on the other side milk, and
- in between was flowing the "pure Drink" (Sharabe Tahoora)
- coloured red like rubies (Yaqoot).
- I have never witnessed such a beautiful view before, nor wine (the wine referred to here is not the usual intoxicating liquid, rather it is a pure drink reserved for the believers in Paradise) flowing between water and milk.
- Imam (A.S.) said, "As is written in the Qur'an, that in Paradise flows rivers of milk, water and wine, verily this stream flows from it. There are beautiful trees on both sides of this river, and between the trees the 'houries' of Paradise are standing with their beautiful hair flowing in the air, the likeness of which cannot be seen in this World".
- . Then the Imam (A.S.) went towards one of the 'houries' and asked for a drink.



- The houri' saluted Imam (A.S.) and filled the cup with water from the stream and presented it to Him. Imam (A.S.) gave the cup to me to drink. 1 drank and was surprised for I had
- never tasted such a delicious and tasty water in my life,
- nor ever smelt such fragrance of musk.
- I said, "May my life be Your ransom, the likeness of what I saw today can never be imagined in my life".
- Imam Sadiq (A.S.) replied, "Whatever you have seen is quite less when compared to the blessings reserved for Our Shi'ahs.
- When anyone among them dies,
- · their spirits stroll in these gardens, and
- drink and bathe in these streams, and
- thus gain pleasure by consuming the delicious fruits".

HOLY PROPHET S.A.W'S DESCRIPTION

- The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) told Imam Ali (A.S.), "The Spring of Kausar flows from
- · beneath the high heavens.
- It's water is whiter than milk,
- sweeter than honey, and
- softer than ghee.
- It's pebbles are of topaz (Zabro Jad),
- rubies (yaqoot) and

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- corals (Marjan).
- It's grass of saffron (Za'faran), and
- mud of musk (Mushke Azfar)".
- Then the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S) placed his hand on the side of Imam Ali (A.S.) and said,
- "O Ali! This stream is for me and your self, and those who love you".



Ali (A.S.) will be the Distributor of kausar (saqiye kausar). The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) told Ali (A.S.):

- "O Ali! verily you are the distributor of (the water of) kausar". It is related in khisaal of Shaikh Sadooq that the Commander of the faithful Ali (A.S.) said,
- "I along with my progeny (Ahlulbait) will be standing besides the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.S.) near the spring of kausar.
- Whoever wishes to meet us should
- strive to emulate our ACTIONS and
- WORDS.
- For every house has some generous and noble people.
- Intercession (Shafa'at) is surely there for our friends.
- Hence strive to meet us there.
- For we shall shun away our enemies from there and give our friends to drink from it.

- And whoever drinks a sip from that blessed water will never become thirsty.
- It is written in the <u>SAHEEH OF BUKHARI</u> that when some of the companions of the Prophet (S.A.W.S.) will be removed from the kausar, the Prophet (S.A.W.S.) will say,
- "o my Lord! these are my companions
 Allah will reply, "You do not know what they did after you.
- They spread false traditions and made changes in religion (Bid-at)
- This tradition is also quoted in the NINTH VOLUME OF THE SAHEEH OF MUSLIM.

Holy Prophet s.a.w said:

Crave and strive for jannat, the world is nothing compared to just a small nook in it

AS WE ENTER PARADISE:

GRADES OF HEAVEN

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- Harith's mother came to the Prophet (SAW), Harith had been martyred during the battle of Badr.
- She said: "O Prophet of Allah! You know how much I loved him. If his reward is heaven, than I
 will not cry but if not than you see what I will do before you."
- The Prophet of Allah (SAW) said: "Is that just one heaven?
- There are very many heavens and your son is in the best of them, Al-Firdous Al-Aala."
- The Prophet of Allah (SAW) said:
- Indeed, there are <u>hundred grades</u> of the Heaven and the distance between the two grades
 is as great as between the heaven and earth. Allah has prepared these grades for those
 who perform Jihad in the way of Allah.


HEAVEN WILL BE WONDERFUL

- he will exclaim, "I have not been harmed, o Lord, seeing what you have give me in exchange


WHAT IF A GOOD PERSON DIED, AND NO ONE PRAYED FOR HIM

Imam ali a.s said: when a momin dies, his 2 angels go to inform allah that so and so has died and no one will pray for him. Allah s.w.t commands them to descend on the earth and pray beside him grave, Glorifying me UNTIL THE DAY OF JUDGEMENT. And then record your actions for him in his list of deeds for his reward

WE WILL MEET IMAMS!!

This is the promise contained in the Qur'an:

"Those who obey the commands of God and His Messenger shall be resurrected together with, and enjoy the company of, those upon whom God has bestowed His kindness and favor in full measure the prophets, the sincere devotees, the martyrs and the righteous. What noble and



precious companions they are!" (4:64).

It should be remarked, of course, that enjoying the company of God's chosen elite does not imply equality with them in terms of spiritual station and degree. While being in close contact with them, the virtuous will enjoy God's favor and blessings to an extent commensurate with their own ranks and degrees of closeness to God. Not everyone will enjoy an equal share, in just the same way that not everyone attains the same degree of ascent.

LAND AND WEATHER OF HEAVEN

The Prophet of Allah (SAW) said:

"And then I was showed in the heaven, I saw there were camps made of pearls and the soil was of musk."

The Qur'an says of the dwellers of the heaven: They will see there neither the sun's (excessive heat) nor the moon's excessive cold.

TREES IN HEAVEN

The Prophet of Allah (SAW) said:

Indeed, there is a tree in heaven so big that if a person keeps riding on a brisk Madhamar (a specially bred horse) for a hundred years even then he would not reach the end of that tree.

EACH TREE IS OF GOLD

There is no tree in the heaven that does not have a trunk of gold.

A TREE THAT WILL MANUFACTURE ROBES

There is a tree in the heaven, which will manufacture robes for the dwellers of the heaven. That tree is called Tuba.

Tuba is a tree in the heaven, which spreads out as much as a distance that can be covered in a hundred years. Robes for the dwellers of the heaven will sprout from its buds.

FRAGRANCE

According to Ahadith, the scent of the Heaven can be smelled from a distance of 70 years.

MANSIONS IN HEAVEN

The Prophet of Allah (SAW) said:

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Indeed, there will be a mansion made of pearls for a believer. It will be spread over an area of 60 miles, and in it will be the household of a believer who will visit them but they will not be able to see each other.

NO SLEEP IN HEAVEN

The Prophet of Allah (SAW) said:

Sleep is the sisiter of death and the dwellers of the heaven will not sleep (Silsalatul Ahadith)

THE BAZAAR OF HEAVEN

It is reported on the authority of Anas bin Malik (RA): The Prophet of Allah (SAW) said:

Indeed, there is a bazaar in the heaven where the dwellers of the Heaven will come on every Friday. The northerly wind will spray scent on them and this will enhance their beauty. And when they will return to their homes, their households will say "By Allah, your beauty has enhanced." "So has yours," they will return the compliment. (Muslim)

In short, they will be overwhelmed by Allah's favours.

And when you look, it is there you will see a bliss and a realm magnificent. (Ad-Dahr: 20)

CAN WE GET JANNAT?

Hazrat Luqman to his son:

- HAVE HOPE IN GOD
- "My son entertain good expectations from Allah without losing fear of His punishment.
- A fear of His punishment should not make you despair of his mercy".
- His son said, "The heart is one; how can it contain hope and fear at one and the same time"?
- Luqman alaihissalam replied, "A Mo'min is such as if he possessed two hearts: one teeming with hope and other equally full of fear."

(6th imam-don't let hope make u arrogant, don't let fear make you hopeless)

It is related from Imam Ja'far-as-Sadiq (A.S.) in "Sifatush Shi'ah" that He (A.S.) said, person who does not believe in the following four things is not from our Shi'ahs: (1) Me'raj (ascention) of Prophet Mohammad (S.A.W.S). (2) Questioning in the grave by Munkir and Nakeer, (3,) Existence of Paradise and hell and (4) Our intercession (shafa'at)".
